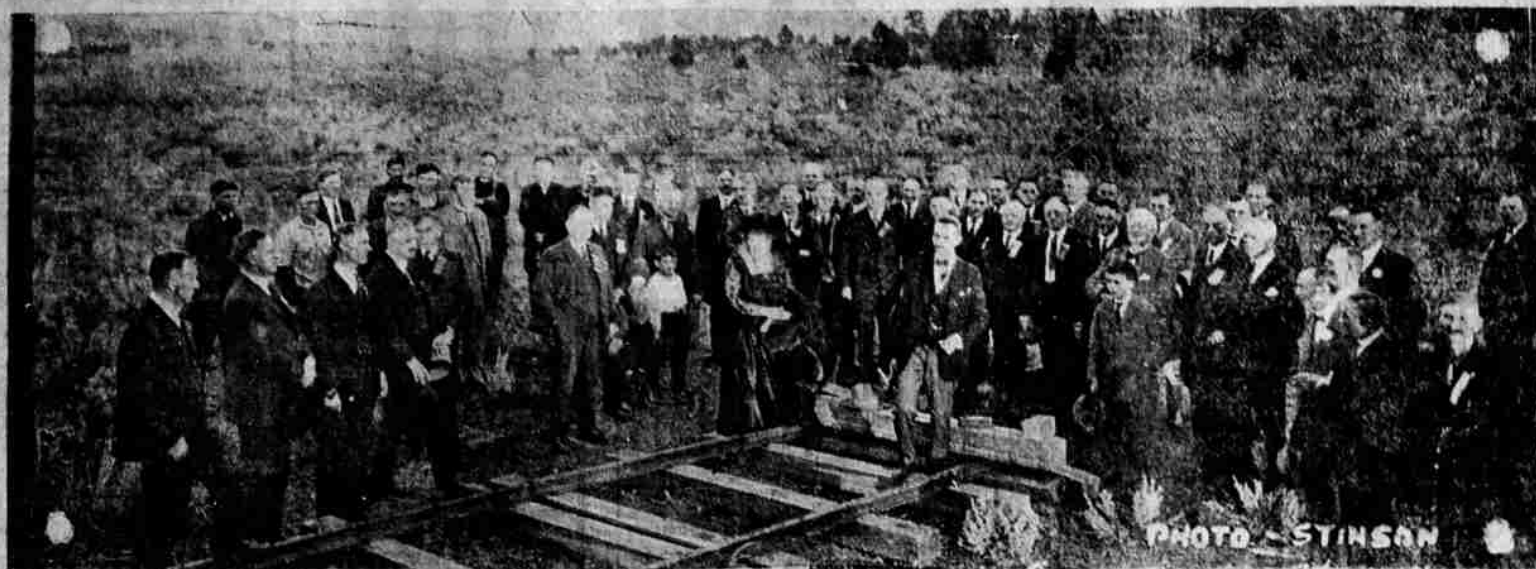

PHILIPPINES HAVE NO IMMIGRATION PROBLEM

MANILA, Oct. 22.—The Philippine Islands will not be disturbed with an immigration problem for some years to come if the present rate of immigration is continued. A total of less than 4,000 immigrants came to the islands during the first six months of the present year, according to reports obtained from the customs service.

Chinese comprised the bulk of immigrants, 3,361 out of a total of 39,320 of those seeking permanent residence in the islands being Chinese. Of these 1,185 were minors under 14 years of age.

Japanese subjects made a poor second with a total of 248, Eng-

lish 60, Spanish 57, Indians 22, Germans 20; all other nationalities made up only 52.

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REFORESTATION HELD GREATEST NEED OF WEST

logged over land will be taxed only a nominal sum for a minimum of 50 years, and when the timber has matured and is cut and sold, a yield tax will be charged. In this manner, Senator McNary holds, the owner will be encouraged to adopt reforestation measures for the benefit of future generations, knowing that the timber itself will pay the tax due the government and not the idle land.

Lower Freight Rates
Lower freight rates on bulky commodities shipped from the west to the east, is also necessary for the prosperity of the west, said Sen-

ator McNary. This matter, he said, he had discussed with Herbert Hoover, and the latter favored higher rates on non-essentials, such as silverware, shipped from the east, and lower rates on lumber and other bulky products from the west. Western lumbermen have as their competitors the lumber districts of the south, from where a lower rate prevails to eastern markets. Rate adjustment will place western manufacturers on a par with those of the south.

It is probable, said Senator McNary, that congress by resolution will direct the interstate commerce commission to remedy this condition.

Will Assure Great City
Reforestation will assure a great city here for many years to come, and all citizens of the county should do all within their power to

conserve the forests, the speaker concluded.

W. O. Smith presided at the reception, which was attended by 70 persons. The chamber of commerce quartette, with several well chosen selections, and Miss Augusta Parker, in pleasing solos, formed the entertainment. With conclusion of the speaking, many of those present took advantage of the opportunity to meet Oregon's senior senator.

The "Guide Trust" at the Capitol in Washington, D. C., is to be broken up. This system allowed a coterie of a few men to charge practically an "admission fee" to the American people for the privilege of seeing their own National Capitol. The Federal Government will operate a guide system free of charge.

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
