HAVE LEGION POST

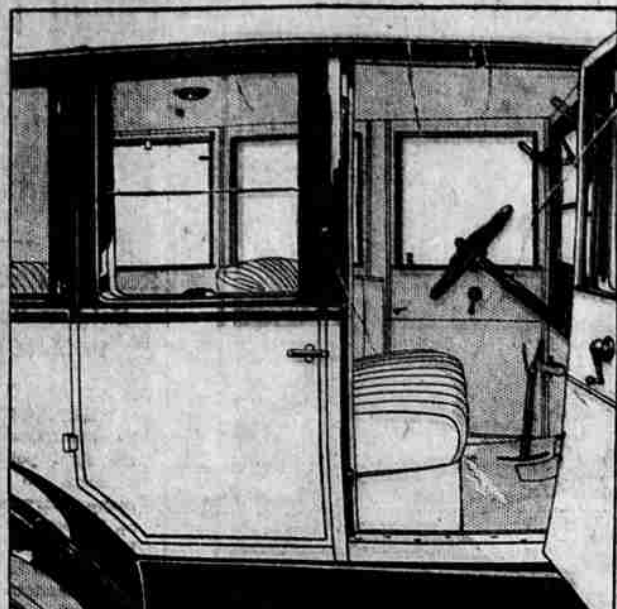
DAYVILLE, Ore., Nov. 24.—Eighteen World War veterans of this city, have organized and made application for a charter for a post of
