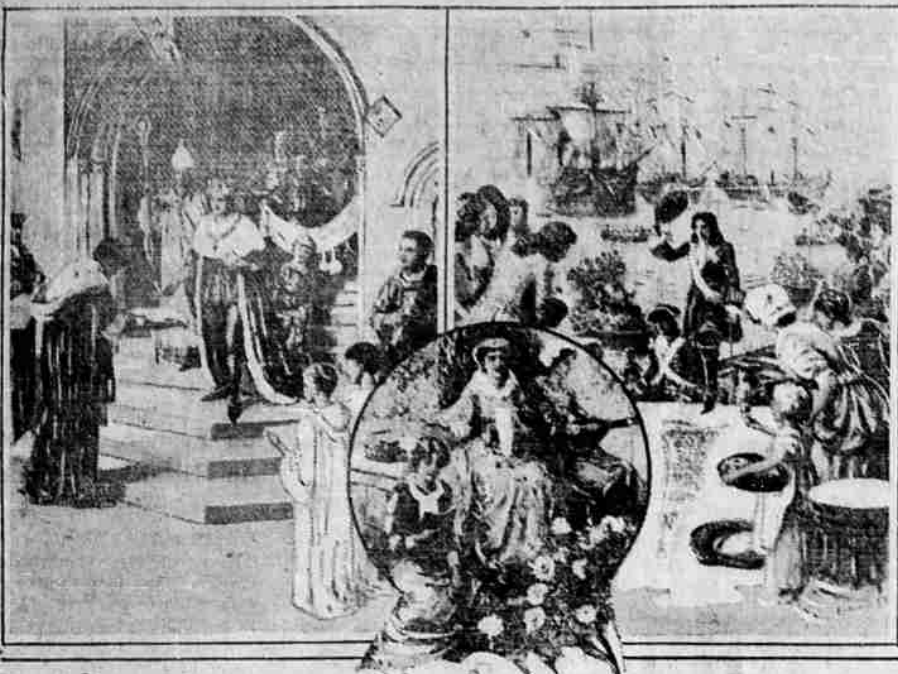


World Events and People as Seen by Camera
