GOVERNMENT OFFERS BIG TIMBER HOLDING

ROSEBURG, Ore.—Approximately 375,000,000 feet of timber, comprising about 5500 acres on the watershed of Laying Creek, a tributary of Rogue river, is being offered for sale by the local forest service office. The timber is all on the Unpugna national forest, four miles above Rufada. The average stand per acre is 64,000 board feet. Many inquiries regarding the timber have been received at the forestry office.

'HOBBO SHEIK' WEARS PILLOW CASE ABOUT HEAD

SON BUYS BACK MINE SOLD BY FATHER

SAN FRANCISCO, Calif.—The Empire mine in Nevada county yesterday justified its purchase years ago by William B. Bourne, Sr., California pioneer, who was forced to put a \$250,000 mortgage on a downtown block here to carry the deal through, when his son William B. Bourne, bought back the block, bounded by Market, Pine and Front streets, for \$1,000,000. He bought it out of proceeds of the old mine, once considered worthless and now reputed one of the best producers in the west.

THREE MILLION TO BE REPRESENTED AT CHURCH MEETING

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 4.—Delegations from all Presbyterian and Reformed churches of the United States, Canada and South America, representing more than 3,000,000 membership are expected to attend the annual meeting of the World Alliance of Presbyterian and Reformed churches to be held at Newport News, Va., February 26, 17 and 28, according to announcement tonight by Dr. Henry B. Muester, American secretary of the Alliance.

Dr. Muester said that the results expected from the meeting include a new appreciation of the dangers lurking in Soviet propaganda; a new sense of the duty of American Presbyterians to their destitute and afflicted brethren in Europe, and the binding together of all the constituent bodies of the alliance in a closer loyalty to Christ.
