CHICO BOY HEIR TO \$300,000 FORTUNE.

CHICO, Calif.—The bulk of the estate of Henry M. Briscoe, Butte County pioneer, who died a week ago is left to his 11-year-old grandson, Jack Briscoe, under the terms of his will, made public here yesterday. The estate is valued at approximately \$300,000, consisting mostly of bonds and money in banks.

OROVILLE MILLS TO START APRIL 1.

OROVILLE, Calif.—Mill and woods crews of the Hutchinson Lumber Company are to begin operations in full swing on April 1. On that

date fully 1,000 men will be working either in the woods to the eastward from Oroville or in the mill in this city. Three big saws will begin the sawing of lumber, and will turn out approximately 225,000 board feet during each single shift. Later in the year it is planned that the mill will operate a double shift.
