

HITS COP, GOES TO HOSPITAL

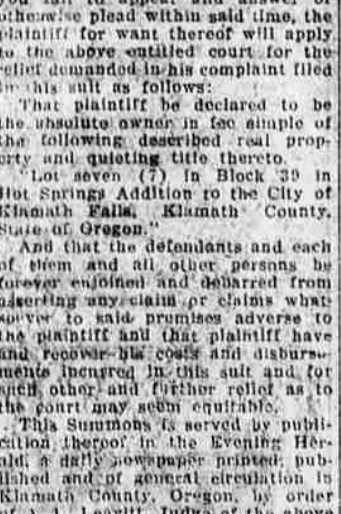

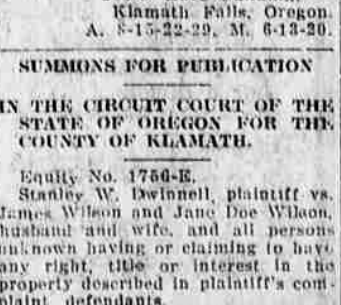
