**'CASEYS' READY
FOR INITIATION**

Knights of Columbus to
Confer Degrees at All-
Day Program

Local Knights of Columbus have completed arrangements for tomorrow's elaborate initiatory program in Klamath Falls, to be attended by several hundred visiting knights from all parts of California and Oregon, in addition to the entire membership of the local "Casey" council.

P. J. Hanley of Portland, state deputy for Oregon, will arrive here tomorrow morning, heading a party of Rose City knights.

The Albany council K. of C. degree team is expected here tonight. Numerous other delegations are due this afternoon and evening and tomorrow mornin, by train and automobile caravans.

Supreme Warden David F. Supple of San Francisco, who is to confer the major degree to the large class of candidates awaiting initiation, is due here tonight from San Francisco. Supple is one of the best-known officials of the "Casey" order, being a pioneer of the K. of C. organization west of the Rocky mountains. He served as state deputy for the California Jurisdiction for the past five years. Supple served as general chairman of the Knights of Columbus 1921 supreme convention in San Francisco.

He will be assisted in tomorrow's ritualistic program by officials of Oregon state councils.
