AT THE PINE TREE

History repeated itself in such way as to prove the true-to-life story told in "The Sign of the Cactus," Blue Streak Western, in which Jack Hoxie is to be starred in the Pine Tree theatre next Saturday. It was after the picture had been filmed that there came the proof in question, and the end of the situation of proof is not yet.

"The Sign of the Cactus" is the story of a dispute between ranchers and a big irrigation company, and today such a dispute is in progress in the Owens Valley, through which runs the big pipe line that conveys to Los Angeles its water supply. The ranchers in the valley contend that they were made certain promises of water in return for rights they surrendered and that these promises have not been kept.

Only a comparatively short time ago an attempt was made to dynamite the aqueduct but the damage done was not great. Also representatives of the city government had been forcibly driven from the district and the ranchers virtually are up in arms to prevent an investigation.

Clifford Smith directed "The Sign of the Cactus," and the supporting cast includes such well known screen performers as Helen Holmes, Josef Swickland, Frances Ford, J. Gordon Russell, Jack Pratt, Frank Bewberg, Muriel Frances Dans and Bobby Gordon.

AT THE LIBERTY

Gene Stratton Porter's stirring novel, "The Girl of The Limberlost", will be the feature film showing today at The Liberty. The screen version is fully as interesting as the novel and should provide real entertainment to movie fans.

"The Lone Star Ranger," the famous best-seller by Zane Grey which has been made into a motion picture with Tom Mix in the starring role, has been read by more than ten million people since its publication in 1915, according to Harper Brothers, publishers.

The noted author's work has been through more than seventeen editions and from the demand that still exists it is likely that it will pass through many more before it is finally shelved.

The book has been translated in many foreign languages and found fertile soil in the readers of these countries. The film will be shown at the Liberty Theatre Saturday only.
