STATE STEPS IN WITH SOLUTION OF TOLL FIGHT

State Highway Will Be Cleared of Snow and Open Road to Bend

Clouds of discontent over the toll road controversy were dispelled yesterday afternoon when the state highway commission authorized the local state highway office to take immediate steps to clear snow from six miles of The Daines-California highway on the Sand Creek hill.

The action of the commission followed a request by the Pollock Bay Lumber company to the U. S. Bureau of public roads to have the road cleared, in order that the lumber concern might have free access to lumber camps. The bureau of public roads, under agreement with the state highway commission, have charge of the maintenance of the state highway north of the Fort Klamath junction.

Bureau Passes Buck
The bureau of public roads referred the matter to the state highway commission, and the order for the clearing of the road followed.

In six days, the snow will be cleared from the highway, local state highway engineers estimated. This will preclude any controversy over tolls as tolls can not be charged on a state highway. The section of road in question, was detour around the Sand creek hill. Inasmuch as

traffic will not be forced to be routed that way, the state highway route will undoubtedly be taken.

Hearing To Be Held
However, despite the action of the commission, the hearing on the toll road contract, will take place as scheduled for next Saturday. Representatives from Klamath civic bodies and from the Bend Commercial club will be present at the hearing to present arguments against the signing of the contract allowing the Central Auto Service to charge tolls on the roads. That the contract will not be signed is a foregone conclusion, according to reports.
