### BOOTLEGGING OF ALIENS CHARGED

**Gigantic Scheme to Get Armenians Through Officials Suspected**

OTTAWA, Mar. 27.—Existence of a great system of "bootlegging" in humanity, whereby Armenian immigrants were smuggled or brought into the United States and Canada on passports illegally obtained, has been charged by George H. Alexander, an Armenian on trial here for conspiring to obtain a passport under false pretenses.

Letters produced by Alexander implicated officers of the Canadian department of immigration and evidence produced indicates that the alleged system had ramifications in New York city.
