PENDLETON, March 28.—Ira Dern, Salt Lake City light heavyweight wrestler, made short work of Abe Caplan, Chicago light heavyweight here last night when he took two straight falls. The first came in 41 minutes with a combination leg split and leg strangle, while the second was in six minutes with an arm scissors and body pin. Caplan put up a game fight, but was unable to offset Dern's speed and strategy.

OXFORD DEFEATED BY WIND IN RACE

PUTNEY, March 28.—The annual Oxford-Cambridge boat race ended sensationally this afternoon when the Oxonians after rowing about two miles in very rough water, were forced to abandon the contest owing to the waterlogged condition of their boat.

Cambridge, which started the general favorite, was lucky in winning the toss which enabled the light blues to select the north shore for their station, thereby gaining protection from the strong north wind which was not only biting cold, but badly roughened the water.

Ashland-Klamath Falls Highway
Junction Pacific-Klamath Falls: Macadamized and in good condition.

Klamath Falls-Lakeview Highway
Klamath Falls-Bonanza: Macadam. Bonanza-Drews Valley section: Unimproved road. Rough going on account of mud. Drews Valley section: Macadam. Drews Valley-Lakeview: Dirt road in fair condition.

Crater Lake Highway
Medford, Trall, Prospect, Fort Klamath: Macadam; open Medford to Prospect. Closed through Crater Lake National Park on account of snow.

The Dalles-California Highway
NOTE: Through traffic advised to take Sherman highway.

The Dalles, Dufur, White River: Good macadam.

White River, Maupiti: Take old road. Chains required after rains.

Maupiti-Cow Canyon: Earth road. Chains required.

Sisters-Cline Falls-Redmond: Macadam.

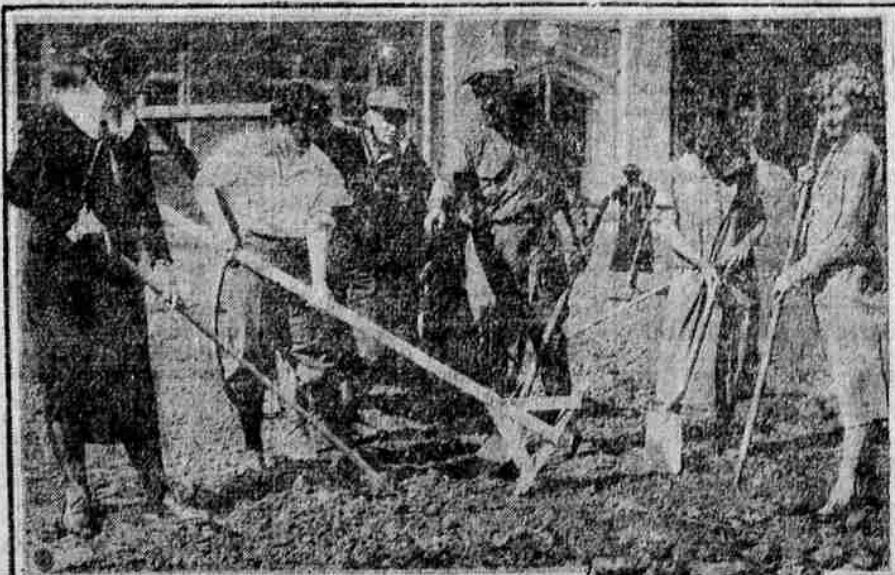
McKenzie-Bend Highway

Free county ferry across Willamette River at Harrisburg. Best route Albany to Junction City is via Corvallis and Monroe; all paved.
