EUROPE HIT BY PUZZLE CRAZE

ROME, April 3.—The cross-word puzzle craze has reached Italy in its triumph march from the United States.

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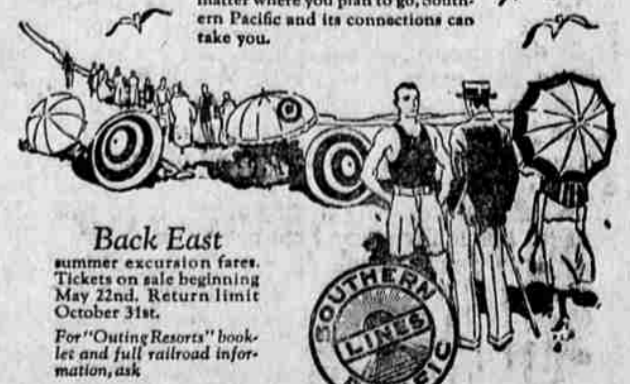

KLAMATH FALLS HAS GOOD CHANCE TO ENTER NEW BASEBALL LEAGUE

Klamath Falls will be admitted to the Siskiyou county baseball league by reason of the failure of the Hornbrook-Hill boosters to post the necessary forfeit. This is the word which was received here today.

Secretary Jameson of the California league is expected to meet with the local baseball committee. The meeting will be held at the chamber of commerce. At this meeting the question of forfeit money, salary limits and other important features of the league will be considered. The league season will start on May 17.

According to Secretary Jameson, each team must post \$250 cash forfeit and a \$150 indemnity bond before the playing season. The \$250 is to be used in league expenses, while the indemnity bond is to be forfeited in case a team drops out of the league.
