STRAY HORSES TO BE IMPOUNDED BY POLICE, IS EDICT

Two big gray horses led this morning to the city pound by Mayor Fred A. Goddard and City Patrolman Hardell testified to a new era in enforcement of the pound ordinance.

Unclaimed horses that wander in from the country and trample on gardens and lawns of local residents will be taken in charge by police authorities, led to the city pound and after due notice is published, will be sold according to due process of law.

"Instead of driving the range horses out of the city, only to have them wander in again during the night and be a nuisance to home owners, the city will exert their authority under the pound ordinance," Mayor Goddard said this morning.

"If the stipulations of the pound ordinance are followed explicitly, there would be no chance of anybody to challenge the right of the city to sell the horses," City Attorney J. H. Casnahan said today.
