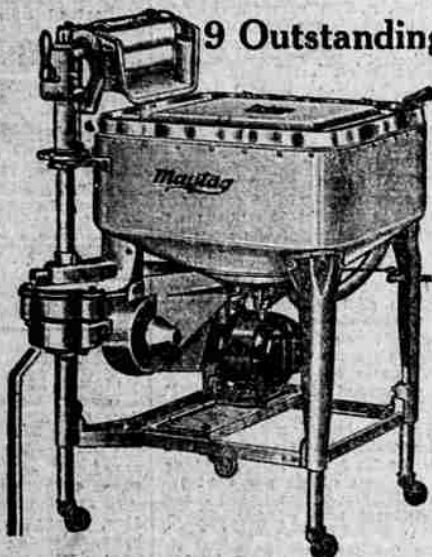

CANDIDATES FOR CITY NINE SHOW ABILITY IN GAME

Next Friday

Several dozen candidates for positions on the Klamath Falls baseball team were given an opportunity yesterday afternoon to display their ability under fire, when the city team played the Pelican Bay Lumber company nine a practice game at Pelican City. Klamath Falls won by a score of 13 to 12.

Everybody was given a chance. Manager Fred Glover ran the players in three inning shifts, putting in three teams during the game. Unexpected talent was displayed by a number of try-outs.

It was a "Rookie" game from the opening inning to the close, and served its purpose in giving Manager Glover an opportunity in checking up on players.

The pitchers who have showed to best advantage to date are Arnold, Pruett, Street, Hogan and Phillips.

Mr. Glover said. Bannister and Franey appear to be the best timber for the receiving position.
