## AGRICULTURAL OUTLOOK FELT TO BE BETTER

### Optimism Prevails Among Klamath Farmers and Livestockmen

A general feeling of optimism among both dry farmers and farmers on irrigation projects, is reported by County Assessor Bill Lee, and his deputy, Maurice Johnson, following extensive assessing trips to all sections of the county.

"The farmers are beginning to see the dawn of a new day," said Mr. Lee, referring to water users on the irrigation projects. "Last year, for example, no relief was in sight. They were up to their ears in debt, and the horizon looked black generally."

"This year things look better. There is relief for them in the cost of maintaining their lands, relief that will be furnished by the government. The mire of debt into which farmers were gradually sinking has released its hold. Favorable weather gives promise of good crops. In general the outlook is brighter for the farmer than for many years."

**Weather Helps**  
Mr. Johnson, who has been visiting dry farm sections of the county, reports a similar feeling.

"Last year, the spirits of dry farmers were down to zero," he explained. "Lack of rain during the early spring, when it was most needed contributed to crop failures. This year however, rain has fallen at a

time when most needed and the dry farmer is assured of more prosperous times this year."

The serious condition of livestock grazing lands, affected by the exceptional dry year of 1924, does not prevail this year, Mr. Lee pointed out. Whereas last year, range grass was at a premium, this year the hills and valleys are carpeted with the rich bunch grass so necessary for the cattle of this county.

### SUMMER RESORT TO BE ERRECTED ON RESERVATION

Catering to the tourist traffic and the angling population, a summer resort hotel will be erected on the banks of the Williamson river near the Williamson river church, by S. A. Sutton, H. R. Perrin, local architect announced yesterday. Expense of the new structure will approximate \$15,000. To W. C. Ames, has been let the contract for construction.

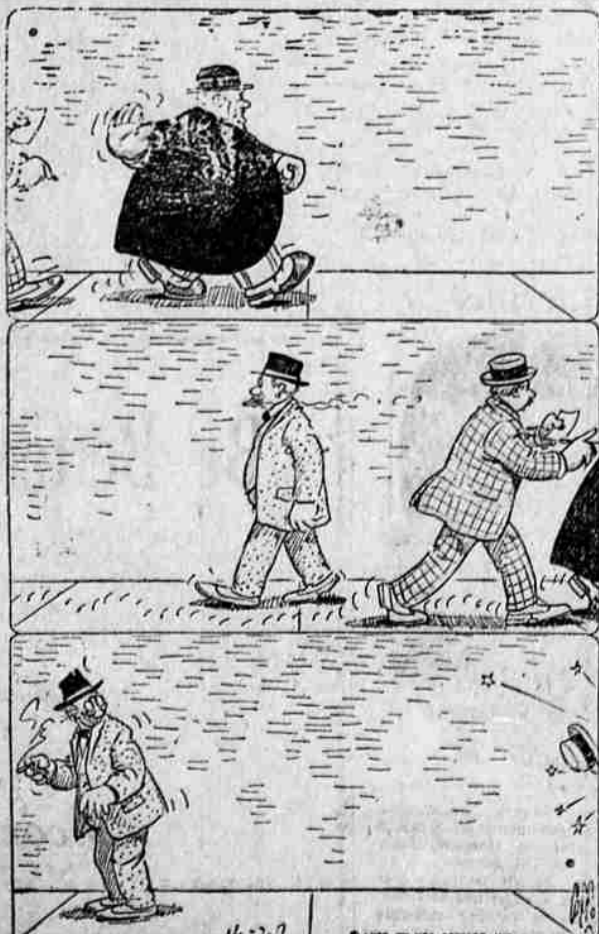
