



**LIGHTING THE HOME**

Electricity as a source of light in our modern home calls for unique and interesting fixtures, all of which must be felt both day and night, without being in any way assertive. Rather a difficult problem to be sure, to so arrange a lamp or other lighting device so that it shall prove useful, charming and capable of throwing just the right amount of light during the evening

and at the same time be a real delight during the day, fitting in correctly with its surroundings. Lamps of every description and for every purpose are on the market today and have become an important part of the home furnishings. The cheery low-powered ball light bids us welcome and gives a suggestion of friendliness and warmth which should be the keynote of every home. And then the living room which is the real index to the home. Is it cold and austere with

harsh, unblinking uncompromising lights in the middle of the room, or are there several lights adjusted for comfortable use about the room? A floor lamp is ornamental and often beautiful in a room but it is not so useful as a bridge or table lamp. A grave mistake is made by many who consider rose a good color for a living room light. Rose belongs to the family of reds and is very trying to the nervous system, especially when one is reading or working by such a light. If one

desires such an effect in the room the shade should be lined with yellow, gold or orange, all of which are good colors for shades and when used as a lining a lower power bulb may be used thus reducing the electric bill. Indirect lighting effects are expensive unless the ceiling and walls are finished with a glazed surface which acts as a reflector. Shades are made of almost any kind of material, but should fit in harmoniously with the other furnishings of the room, and when buying one should consider not only the use and the place for which the shade is intended but the ease with which it will be kept in condition. The parchment shades are perhaps the easiest to care for since they can be wiped off with a damp cloth or freshened with a new coat of shellac; but the safe rule is to buy fixtures, lamps and shades with care, with a real thought as to their usefulness both as lights and as spots of color in the room, for you may ruin your home completely or make it the comfortable beautiful place that every home builder is anxious to secure.

Several lamps should be placed about the room so that each point of interest or group of furniture may be well lighted when in use. The light above the dining table should be bright but not glaring and should be so arranged that the service is made more beautiful by it, while the guests are absolutely unconscious of its presence. Two lights are extremely important in the bedroom. One light over the head of the bed, in the form of a bed lamp attached to the head board and another so arranged on or near the dressing table as to throw light wherever it is needed.

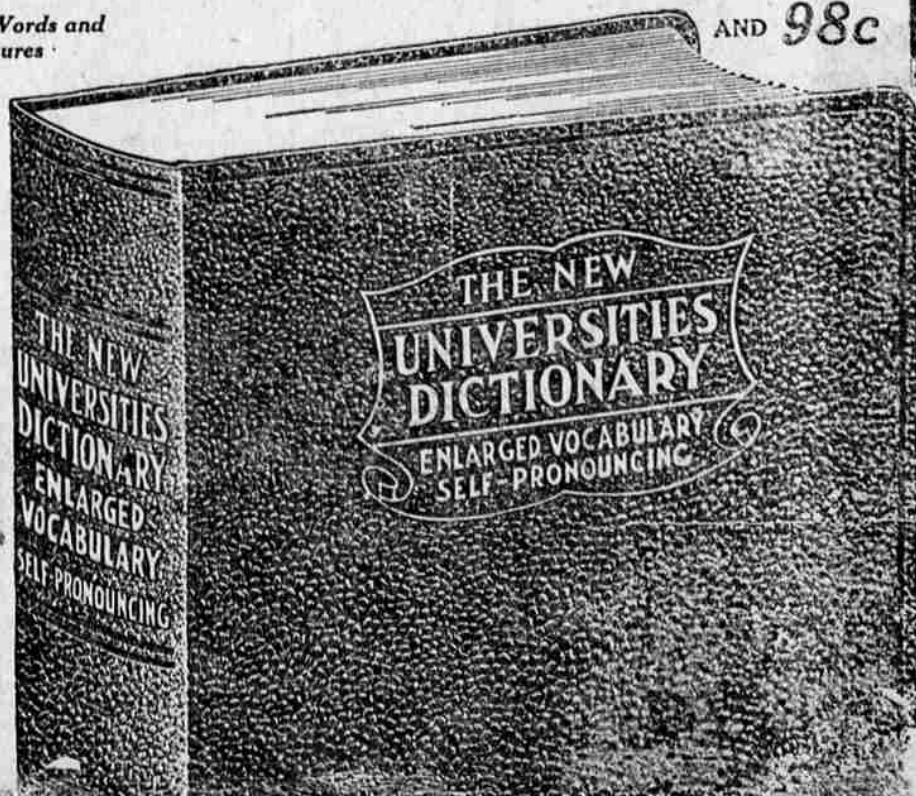
