LOCAL MINERAL WATER CONTAINS RADIO ACTIVITY

Recent results secured in the treatment of rheumatism, eczema and other disease at the Hot Springs Natatorium, indicate that at last the hot springs of this city may come into their own. The owners of the Natatorium recently secured the services of an expert masseur who has had experience in the treatment of diseases at other hot springs and he has demonstrated that the local water is capable of producing similar results to those secured at some of the famous springs of the nation.
