HEAVY FINE GIVEN DRUNKEN AUTOIST

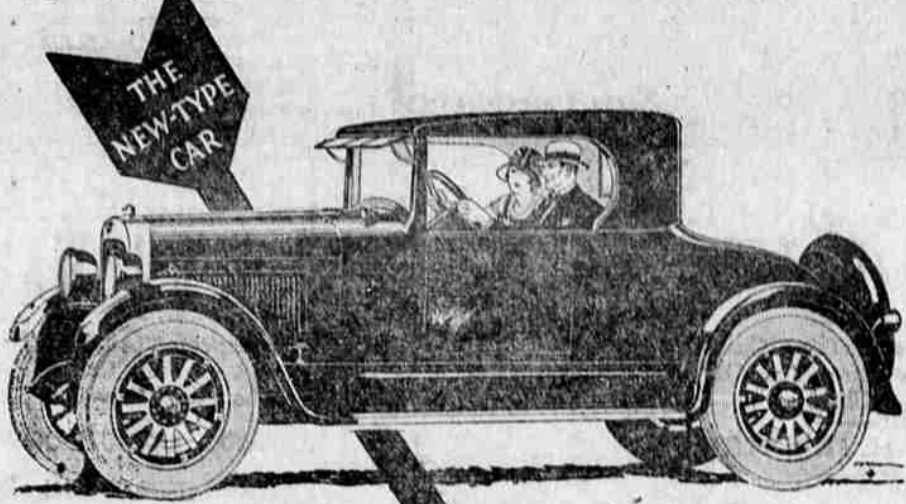

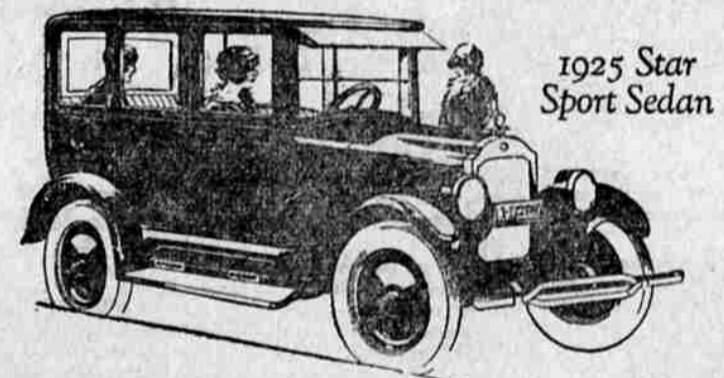
