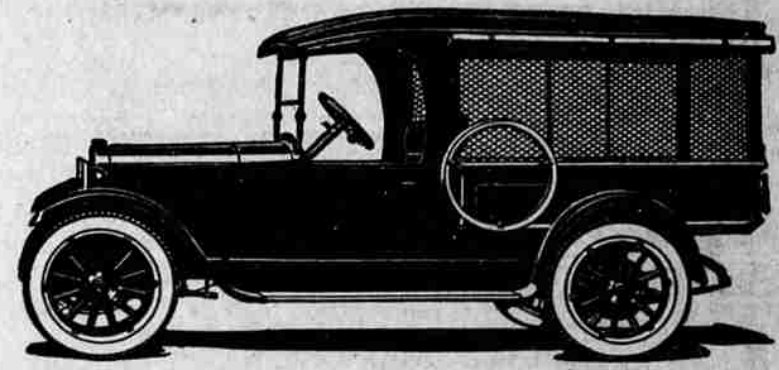

National Bank Resources Big

WASHINGTON, May 19.—Combined resources of the national banks of the United States on April 6, the date of the last bank call, were \$23,832,273,000 or an increase in the last 12 months of \$1,769,575,000.

Every phase of national banking operations showed important increases. Loans and discounts of all the banks aggregated \$12,468,836,000, an increase of more than half a billion in the year since the corresponding bank call of 1924.

Total deposit liabilities amounted to \$19,382,947,000, an increase of \$1,784,251,000 over deposits of a year ago.

SIGN CREW BUSY AT WORK ON ROAD

All information of the road that will acquaint the tourist with necessary facts concerning roads and cities of Klamath county are inscribed on approximately 100 signs that have been erected between Klamath Falls and Bonanza and Klamath Falls and the state line. The sign crew is now working on The Dalles-California highway north from Klamath Falls to the state line and also on the Crater Lake highway from the Port Klamath junction north to the park line boundary.
