It is such a little thing to do in such a GREAT cause.

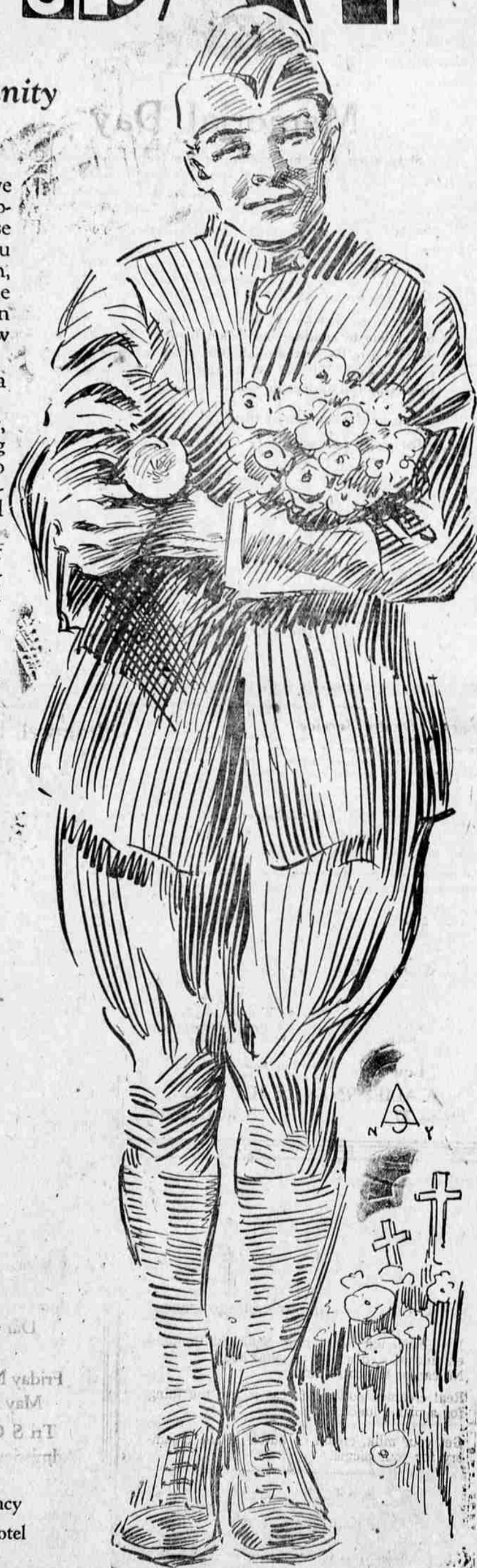
