Fights His Way Through College

LOS ANGELES, May 27. — Fidel La Bara, 19-year-old Olympia fly-weight champion, is fighting his way into college. And they are tough scraps that the young Italian is waging to attain his goal. Forced to capitalize his boxing prowess in order to sup-



port his family, Fidel has not been lured from his ambitions by the glare of the arc lamps and the cheers of boisterous fans.

Cauliflower ears, swollen eyes and broken noses have no attraction for him; he wants to be a stock and bond broker.

"I hope to get a match with Pancho Villa this summer," declares La Bara. "I believe I can beat him and when I enter Stanford next fall, I would like to retire from the ring a champion."

Four and a half years ago Fidel, then 14 years of age, walked into the Los Angeles Athletic Club and told George Blake he wanted to be a boxer. Blake was doubtful as to the ability of the 110 pound youth but he started working with him. Two months later Fidel entered the ring for his first real match and won by a knockout in the second round.

A year ago La Bara won the highest honor in amateur boxing—an Olympia championship.

In the six months he has been a professional, La Bara's earnings have been about \$20,000. He is recognized as the Pacific Coast fly-weight champ and no doubt will rise to higher fame.

Tacoma Lawyer To Defend Gov. Hart

OLYMPIA, Wash., June 2.—Maurice Langhorne, Tacoma attorney, will be chief defense counsel for former Governor Louis F. Hart, in his trial on a charge involving alleged attempted fee splitting in connection with the liquidation of the defunct Scandinavian-American bank of Tacoma. It was announced here today by Hance Clelland, who has been handling preliminary details of the affair.

In making the announcement, Mr. Clelland said that Mr. Hart had called him by telephone from Tacoma, where he is in conference

this morning with his chief counsel, Mr. Langhorne was one of four prominent attorneys in the state who had tendered their services gratis to Mr. Hart, following the filing of the affidavits, Mr. Clelland said.

"Politics has gone by the board in the affair," Mr. Clelland declared. "Of the four attorneys who offered their services to Mr. Hart, two are republicans and two are democrats."

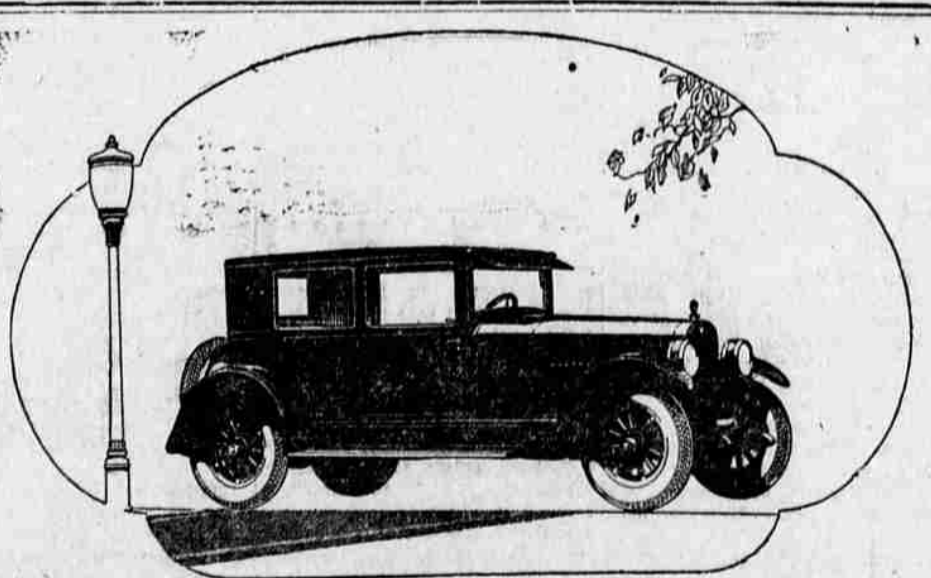
