Urge Students to Study War

SHANGHAI, June 26. (AP)—A meeting of the Shanghai students union yesterday decided to issue an appeal to all Chinese students throughout the country to "learn the art of war and be ready to fight for their country."

It was resolved to petition the military chiefs to select teachers to "arouse the patriotism of the people and soldiers."

The program for students demonstrations in many parts of China yesterday was largely a fiasco, owing to official prohibition of the meetings. The precautions taken at Shanghai completely frustrated the students' activities here.

Many volunteers have been withdrawn from the Shanghai streets, which are resuming a normal appearance.
