## Claim Divine Healer Is Working Miracles

The Divine Healing Revival, that is in progress in San Bernardino, at the corner of Third and Arrowhead streets, is attracting so small amount of attention. In spite of the heavy rainfall the people have continued to flock to the Big Tent where Evangelist A. G. Garr is preaching from night to night, and praying for the sick, blind, deaf and afflicted; many of whom are declaring that they were instantly healed—as the Man Garr prayed for them.

One man, Mr. Smith, of San Bernardino, declared that after the loss of his ear drum, and a constant running discharge from his ear, for 45 years, having been treated by specialists in England, Australia and in different cities of America—and never could be cured, spoke before a large audience under the Big Tent, stating that he was instantly healed, when Mr. Garr prayed for him, and for two weeks he had been free from the offensive odor and the discharge from his ear; and can now hear the clock tick for the first time in that ear in forty-five years.

Another interesting story was told by a man who had his eye sight totally destroyed in one eye, by a nail, and for eighteen years was totally blind in that eye, and was informed by the specialist who gave him the last examination, that the optic nerve was totally dead, and that he could never see with it again, astonished the audience by stating that his eye was instantly opened as the evangelist prayed for him.

Still another testified that she had undergone five operations on her eyes and had been treated by the famous Mayo Brothers of Rochester, Minn., and was suffering excruciating pain most of the time for years. Confined to a dark room, finally being examined by another specialist in San Diego, who declared that she would be compelled to have one of her eyes removed if she hoped to get out of the agony she was in.

She arose before the big crowd under the tent and declared that the instant the evangelist, Mr. Garr, prayed for her, that the pain all left her eyes, and that the dimness also went away and she saw the faces of the people in the audience.

The people of San Bernardino are being astonished by the faith exercised in this peculiar revival, where so many are being instantly healed of all kinds of afflictions, and from all appearances, it seems to be instantaneous.

That something unusual is happening in San Bernardino at this remarkable revival is attested by hundreds of people who are attending from the adjoining towns, and those who are talking about it on the streets and in the shops and homes.

Another peculiar feature is the number of people who go forward to pray in each service.

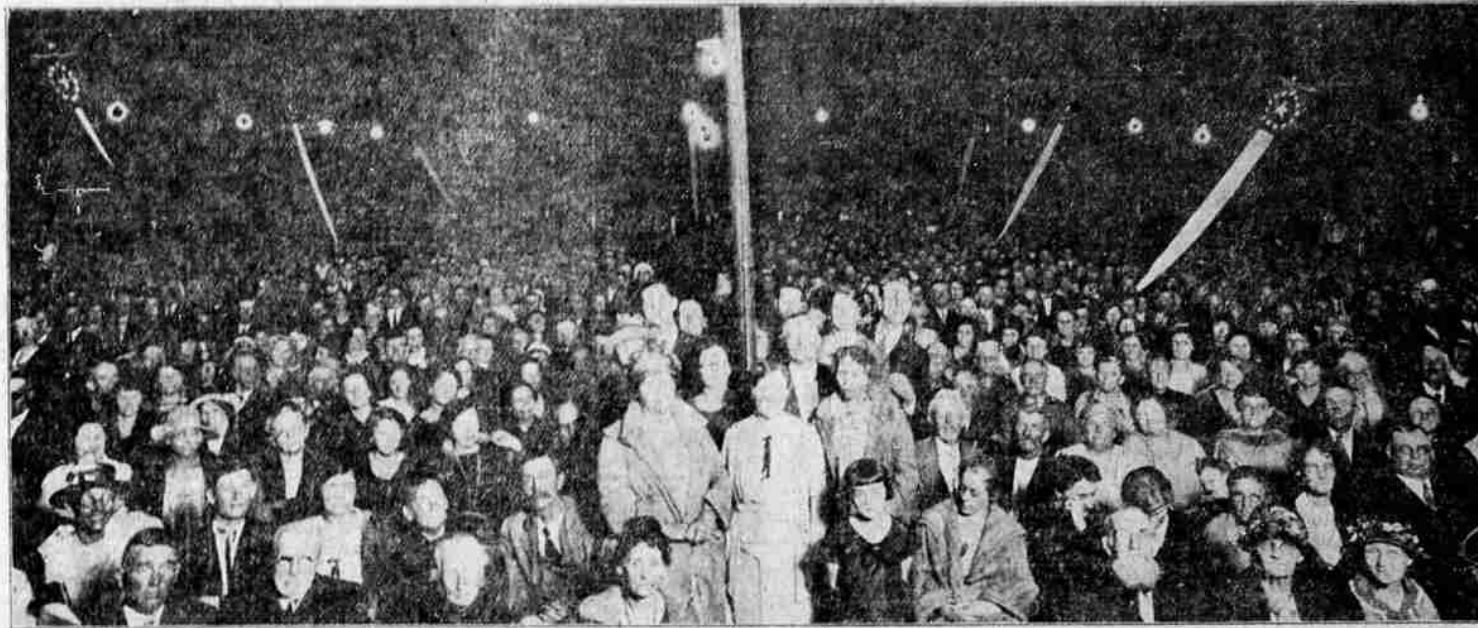
Many religious persons who are accustomed to attending divine healing services, claim that there are the greatest number of instantaneous miracles in this revival that they have ever witnessed.

December 12, 1916, at the age of 7, in Fresno, Calif. I was run over by a street car, was badly broken and crushed.

My pelvis broken on both sides. My right hip and knee broken in two places, my right arm was so badly mangled it had to be amputated above the elbow. Some ribs torn loose and several electrical burns on my body and limbs.

I was in the hospital for seven months. I was under the doctor's care in splints and plaster paris casts the greater part of six years. The doctor in Fresno operated several times, said

I would have to go on crutches. The doctors began to draw in my limbs until I was in a sitting position. My hips were drawn out of socket, not drawn but shoved back. One limb six inches shorter than the other. The doctor in Fresno told my parents I would

have to be operated on again. I could not live long in that condition. He advised them to take me to San Francisco for a bone specialist; so they took me to Dr. T. J. Nolan of San Francisco. He examined me and said he could help me, but it would take two

years. So I was operated on and put back in a cast. We had made six trips to San Francisco and was to go the seventh to be operated on, but the Lord objected.

We received a letter from the doctor stating he had been called out of the

city and would be gone a month, and not to bring me until he returned.

Mr. Garr was holding meetings here in Tulare, so on the very last night of his meeting November 27, 1922, my mother got a wheel chair and wheeled me to the meeting and praise the Lord I was healed on the same day that I should have been operated upon.

At that time I was 13 years of age, weighed 41 pounds, now I weigh over 95 pounds, can walk and am still healed, saved and baptised with the Holy Ghost.

P. S.—The first hospital bill was paid by the street car company which was \$2250.00. Others my parents paid ranging from \$300 to \$500 each.

The next morning after being prayed for the fourteen pound cast was removed and to our surprise and joy my limb had lengthened five and a half inches.

I can now go to school. My parents and sisters and brothers have all been saved through my healing. We are a happy family now.
