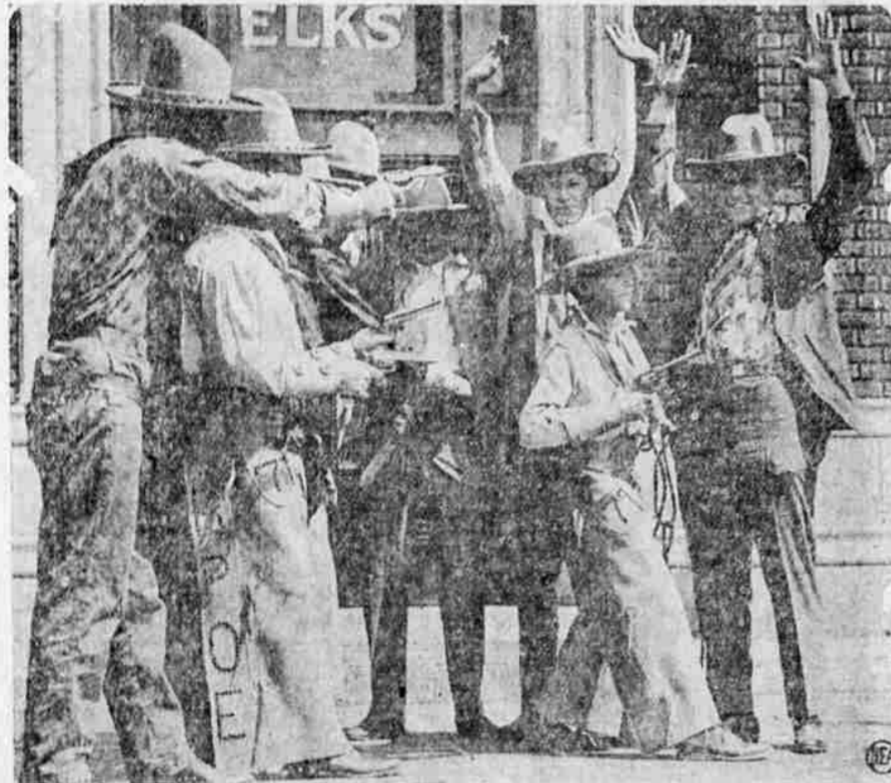

Sheepmen Ask Raker's Help in Washington

Wool Growers Want Wells in Modoc National Forest

Cooperation with Klamath and northern California livestock men, in their endeavor to induce the government to dig wells in the Modoc National forest, was assured the Klamath Woolgrowers Association by J. S. Raker, congressman from the northern California district.

Judge Raker of Alturas listened to the case of the livestock men for several hours yesterday morning. He was told that the national forest could take care of thousands of more head of sheep during the grazing season, providing that wells would be dug by the government at certain locations throughout the forest.

Livestock men, he was told, would be willing to meet their share of the well digging by paying an increased grazing fee.

Mr. Raker gave assurance to the livestock men that he would do all in his power to persuade the government of the need of digging wells in the national forest.

To follow up their advantages, gained by the conference the California congressman yesterday, a committee of southern Klamath and northern California sheepmen will journey next week to Alturas, to confer with the forest supervisor of the Modoc National forest. Purpose of the visit will be to have facts and figures in support of their claims for wells and better grazing privileges, to place before Congressman N. J. Slammatt, when he visits this territory.
