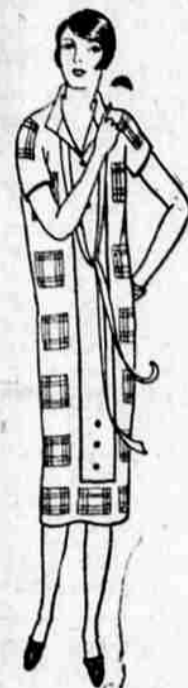

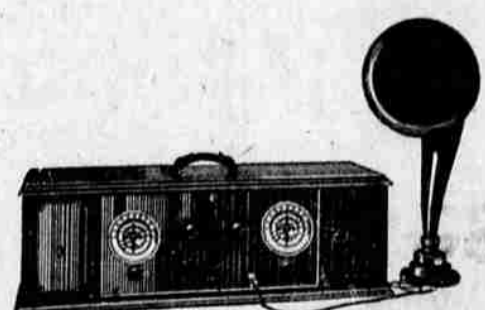
PETERSON HERE
