Girl Killed In Fall From Peak Of Mt. Pilchuck

EVERETT, Wash., Aug. 3.—Mildred Hasselmen, 19, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. J. P. Hasselmen, residing two miles west of Granite Falls, was instantly killed Sunday when she fell from the highest point on Mount Pilchuck.

With Harold Brandt, the girl, against advice of older members of the party, tried to climb a rocky crag on the north side. She fell 300 feet into a snow field and rolled several hundred feet.
