WOMEN HELP TO SAVE HOMES IN BLAZING FOREST

Clatsop County Fire Stopped Before it Reaches Little Town

YOUNGSTERS ALSO AID

Several Serious Blazes Reported at Various Points on Lower River

ASTORIA, Ore., Aug. 8. (AP)—Fighting to save their homes from a forest fire which threatened to wipe out the settlement of Thompson's Sliding in Clatsop county, women and children joined men in an all night battle last night and succeeded in turning the flames back from their homes. This morning the settlement was reported out of danger. The fire had passed entirely around the hamlet and was raging on toward the south.

Fire threatened the Nehalem valley farming country near Jewell today. A force of more than 150 men is fighting the blaze, and additional reinforcements are being rushed from the north. The district fire warden is throwing out all available forces to combat the fire.

The fire which is burning toward the Columbia county line is the most serious that has occurred in northwestern Oregon this year. It is traveling at an unusual speed before a hot dry northwesterly wind. Its progress last night was estimated at six miles by officials at the Kerry Timber company headquarters at Kerry, Ore.

Thus far the fire has burned principally in slashings, but it is known to have destroyed a considerable quantity of green timber of the Ladies Logging company's holdings last night.

Yesterday the fire burned a 300-foot trestle on the Noyes Holland railroad. Although the fire started on the Noyes Holland holdings, it has now passed entirely out of this company's property.

Report Fire in Columbia Forest

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 8.—A new fire was reported this morning in the chain of lakes country in Columbia national forest west of Mount Adams. The fire is about a mile long a quarter of a mile wide, according to the lookout. The train crew of 30 men was on its way to the fire.

The Mount Hood forest also reported a new fire near Raney Lake. Thirty men were on it. The Cedar Swamp Creek and Pinehead fires are now under control. Supervisor T. S. Sherrard telephoned in that the smoke had so hindered the work of lookouts that eight patrolmen were needed.

Two forest fires were burning yesterday south and southwest of Rainier, Ore. One of the fires is just back of the city's water shed in the same district where a fire
