**BUSINESS TRIP**

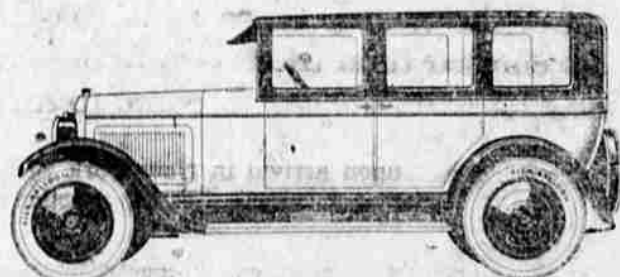
G. H. Lewis arrived in Klamath Falls this morning from San Francisco, and will spend several days here transacting business matters.

Field Representative of Near East Relief Work Returns

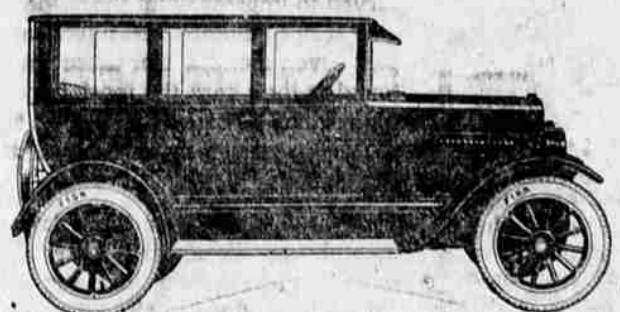
