ITALIAN EMIGRATION IS DECREASING RECORDS SHOW

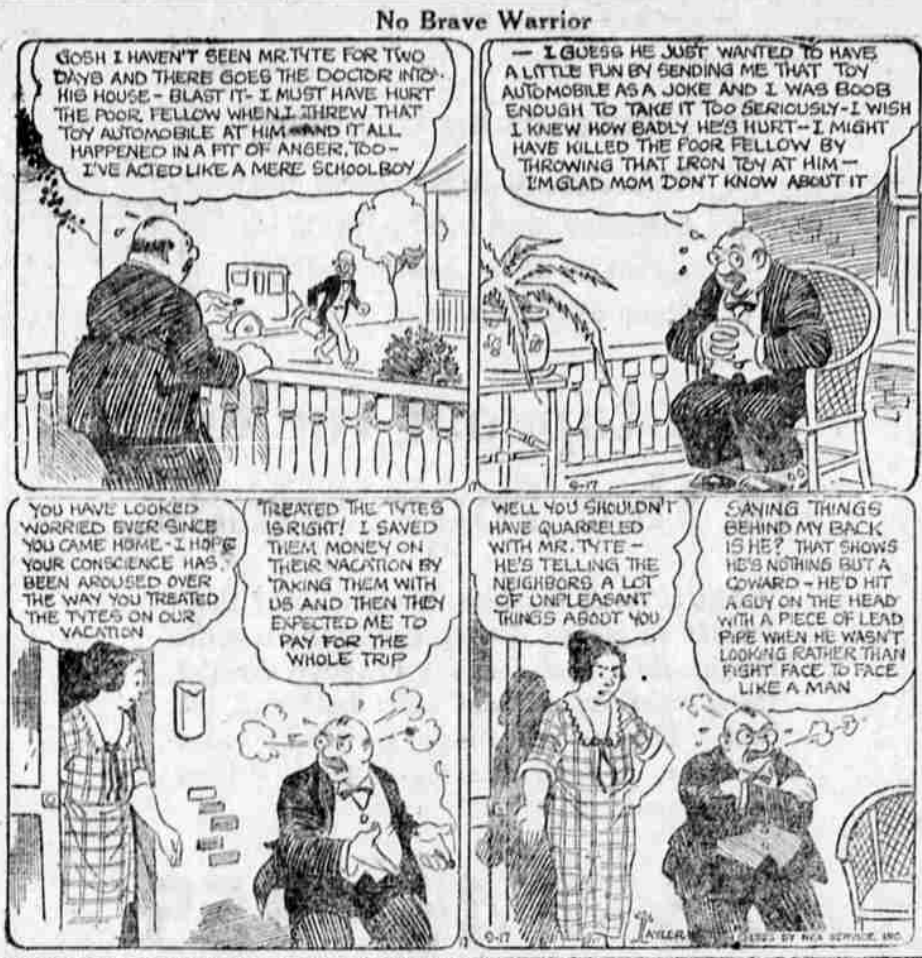

EMPRESS OF JAPAN TAKES CARE OF SILK WORMS TOKYO. — The Empress is as much devoted to sericulture as are the numerous women of Japan's cocoonery constructed in the palace compound and since the beginning of this spring, the Empress has personally bustled herself with taking care of the silk worms and feeding them on mulberry leaves.
