Graham Brothers Sell More Buses

The Street Railway Commission of the City of Detroit and Mayor John W. Smith have approved the purchase of 64 more Graham Brothers twenty-one passenger street car type motor coaches, making a total of 148 bought from Graham Brothers within a year. This action of the commission, taken in accordance with the recommendation of H. U. Wallace, General Manager of the Detroit Street Railways, was later approved by the City Council. General Manager Wallace, in recommending the purchase stated that the 84 Graham Brothers coaches already in service have been operated over 2,000,000 miles and have proved entirely satisfactory.

The Department of Street Railways started motor coach operations on January 1, 1925, and have gradually extended their coach lines until they now operate over routes totaling 52 miles. The new equipment will, when placed in service, increase the mileage of their coach routes by 43 miles, giving them a total of 95 miles. Trolley cars are operating over 395 miles of track, and the 95 miles of new motor coach routes will increase the mileage of the entire transportation system by about 25 per cent.

This indicates the rapid expansion of Detroit's transportation system, making use of street cars and motor coaches, each in its best adaptable field, and thus furnishing to the people a co-ordinated service through the interchange of transfer privileges. The motor coach is taking a leading part in expanding transportation systems by providing service to new districts at a very much smaller investment than would have to be made if tracks and overhead trolley lines were installed.

Civic Clubs Oppose Crane-Odell Railway

Declaring that the Crane - Odell line would retard and keep out the building of the Northern and Southern Pacific lines for years to come, members of the boards of directors of the various southern chambers of commerce, met for their quarterly meeting at Ashland on Monday afternoon. The body went on record as sponsoring the further development of the Crescent City harbor. Keen interest was shown by the members over the hearing of the I. C. C. in Portland on October 5.

At the next meeting of the directors, who plan to hold quarterly get-together meetings, to further the development of southern Oregon as well as to discuss civic and welfare problems, members of the Grants Pass chamber will be hosts. Coming in alphabetical order, Klamath Falls will be the third meeting place. It is expected the meetings will be held once every three months.

Lynn Sabin, secretary of the local chamber of commerce, declared the meeting most successful. He was accompanied to the valley city by Andy Collier and Bert Hall. They attended the luncheon yesterday noon at the Lithia Springs hotel and remained for the dinner given last evening returning home about 9 o'clock.

GERMAN ON POSTCARDS BARRED

ROME.—(AP)—The prefect of Trent has ordered that no picture postcards with German or bilingual captions be sold. This is another effort to make Upper Adige territory, reconquered by Italy during the world war, an integral part of the nation and to minimize Austrian influence there. Pictures and card albums with German captions may be sold only until the end of 1925.

that Shaner had given him the beating in order to elicit a confession.

On the witness stand Shaner had flatly denied having beaten Rivera.

Suddenly, from the rear of the court room, where he was in the custody of Fred Eng, a deputy sheriff, Rivera shouted at the officer: "How did you skin your knuckles, then?"

It was some little time before order was restored.

Stole Stockings

On the witness stand Rivera admitted freely that he had stolen a weird assortment of gaudy silk stockings calculated for the Mexican trade by a local supply company; also an assortment of sombreros manufactured to take the eye of the younger Mexican-about-the town.

He denied however, that Sarazura had any knowledge that the property he had received had been stolen.

When Miss Christine Murdock arose to make the opening address for the defense, she was visibly nervous. She stood at one corner of the jury box resting her left hand on the rail while she talked. She argued in a slightly tremulous voice that there was considerable doubt at issue in the case as the prosecution had failed to prove that Sarazura had any knowledge that the property had been stolen. This doubt, she said, should by law be resolved in favor of the defendant.

Buried Goods

The attorney for the state argued that Sarazura must of necessity had knowledge that the property had been stolen because he had discussed the articles at length and had been able to show the arresting officers where the stuff had been buried.

Listening gravely from the bench while the girl as a legally qualified barrister expounded her theory of the defense, was Judge J. W. Mahon, who has grown gray in his almost 30 years on the superior court bench.

Veteran attorneys followed the course of the brief trial, representing the first time in the history of this county a girl representing the state as prosecutor and another appearing for the defense of a criminal.
