J. R. Pickett and W. A. Caraley, of Sprague River, are out of town guests planning to remain in Klamath Falls over the week end.

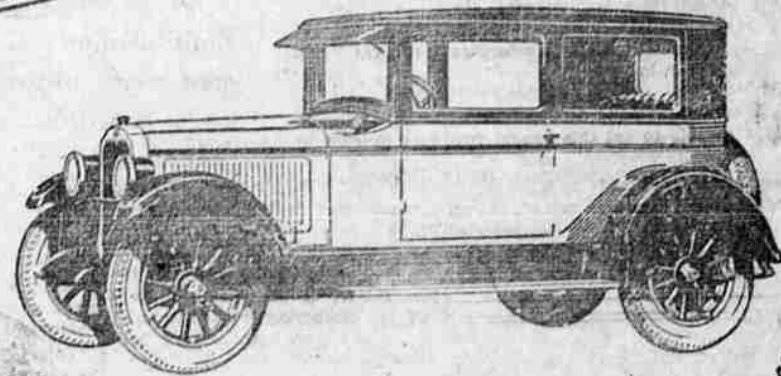
**MRS. O'CONNOR HERE**
