MAJOR LEAGUES FINISH SEASON

NEW YORK, Oct. 5.—The regular major league season has ended with the Senators and Pirates, now preparing for the post season classic, in front of their respective packs by eight and one-half games each.

Three games in each league were played as the curtain fell yesterday. So far as the standing was concerned, the only result was the Cubs' drop into the cellar of the national league through a defeat by the Cardinals.

On the heels of the Senators and Athletics, the St. Louis Browns and Detroit Tigers finished in order in the American league and will share in the world series spoils as will the Reds and Cardinals, who trailed the Pirates and Giants in the first division of the national league circuit.

Rogers Hornsby of the Cardinals led the national batting parade for the sixth consecutive year. He established the national league record for batting last season. His mark, .493, also made him one of the only three men to hit over .400 for three seasons. The others were Jesse Burkett and Ty Cobb.

Harry Heilmann, Detroit outfielder, won the batting crown in the American league for the third time with an average of .393.

Johnny Mostil of the White Sox captured the piffling honors in the American with 22 stolen bases. Max Carey of the Pirates led the senior circuit with 43 thefts.

Hornsby was crowned king of the home run hitters in the majors with 39 blows, three less than his own national league record. Bob Meusel of the Yankees led in the American with 33 homers, while Babe Ruth, holder of the record with 59 circuit blows in one season, finished in a deadlock for second honors in his league with Ken Williams, of the Browns, each having 25.

Stanley Coveleskie of Washington, led the American league pitchers with 29 victories and five defeats. Dazzy Vance of Brooklyn was beaten by Bill Sherdel of the Cardinals for honors in the national. Sherdel won 16 and lost 6, while Vance won 22 and lost 5.

Bottomley of the Cardinals collected the most hits in the national league, 227, while Al Simmons of the Athletics rolled up 259 in his circuit. Cuyler of the Pirates led the run scorers with 144, while Simmons accounted for 121.

ALL RECORDS AT STATE FAIR ARE PUT IN DISCARD

Receipts and Attendance
Last Week Greater than
Ever Recorded Before

SALEM, Ore., Oct. 5.—Both financial receipts and attendance at the Oregon state fair last week broke all previous records, is the claim of state fair authorities in official figures given out yesterday.

Receipts aggregated \$109,699.24 as against \$102,000 in 1923, the biggest fair year financially prior to this year. The total attendance last week was over 85,000, it is claimed, as against 82,700 in 1923. The night horse show this year returned \$5410.75 against \$5220.75 last year, which was the best previous year.

Concessions yielded \$9291.40 as against \$8143.50 last year. Grand stand receipts last year were slightly ahead of this year, \$7353.25 as against \$7269.

Final announcement of awards in the boys and girls club canning contests made Sunday, showed Umatilla county first, Josephine second, Sherman third, Clackamas fourth and Hood River fifth.

In the automobile style show Saturday the silver cup was awarded to E. W. Pettijohn company of Salem.

An experienced team ploughed through a green aggregation Saturday and Klamath County high school went down to defeat before Medford high school by a score of 21 to 0. 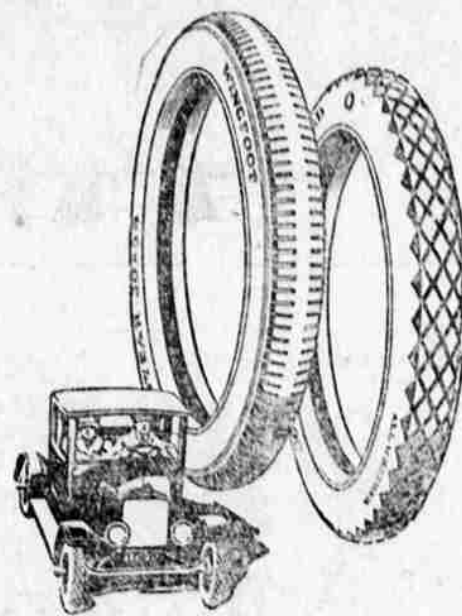

DAIRY RATING OF SEPTEMBER GIVEN

Lost River Dairy Heads List
for Month With
89.5 Per Cent

Remarkably high marks were scored by ten Klamath dairies in the first official sanitary rating announced since the first of the year. Five of ten dairies scored 80 per cent or over and the other five ranged from 67 per cent up to 79.5 per cent.

Inspections were conducted by Leo Craft, special city sanitary officer, under the direction of Dr. E. D. Lamb, deputy dairy and food commissioner. The ratings were based on dairy equipment and methods.

Lost River Dairy scored the highest with a mark of 89.5, while Holiday dairy was second with a score of 82.

conspiracy which resulted in the murders and each equally responsible. No intimation of what lines

the defense will follow has been given by Will R. King, attorney for the three.

Judge Percy R. Kelly is hearing the case.

Many Witnesses

Both attorneys admit that the fate of the three rest practically with the outcome of the Murray trial, and there is little hope that the case will go to the jury in less than 10 days. Already the prosecution has subpoenaed 33 witnesses and the defense has intimated that it will probably call at least half as many.

There is little likelihood, according to the attorneys, that they will be able to secure a jury before late Tuesday, and possibly not by that time. Eleven of the prospective jurors, 10 women and one man, have already filed claims of exemption and it is expected that a second venire will have to be called. Seven women still remain on the jury list still available.

Closely guarded

Taking cognizance of Murray's statement made at the time of his capture that he was "through serving time" every precaution is being taken to guard against an attempted break during the trial. He will be brought to the court house from the prison under heavy guard and, while he will not wear handcuffs in the court room, armed
