### Henry Burke Will Turn Boxer; Klamath Wrestler Signed For Maiden Appearance On Nov. 3

Henry Burke, one of the best middleweight wrestlers on the coast, has given up his punishing wristlocks and toe holds for right crosses and uppercuts.

In other words, the stocky little 160-pounder has leaped from the wrestling mat to the squared arena and he will don the gloves for his first professional appearance as a b-x-fighter in a special event at the next boxing card, Nov. 3, according to announcement today by Johnnie Sylvester, matchmaker.

Sylvester is now scouring the woods for some likely looking middleweight to give Burke his first fistie argument, and the popular ex-wrestler sought to prove a strong drawing card because his friends and supporters will be anxious to see him swap punches.

Burke is no novice as a boxer. He's had a lot of experience with the gloves, although of course, he is by no means a finished fighter. But he started training today and beside of two weeks he expects to be in condition to give a good account of himself against some fair middleweight.

Henry is as strong as an ox and is fast on his feet in spite of his stocky build. If he shows the same proficiency with the gloves as he does on the wrestling mat he ought to work himself up to areal drawing card within a year.

Sylvester is now lining up Johnnie Trambitta, the best boxer of the Trambitta trio, to meet Kid Starkey in the main event, and Earl Stolz have been signed for the semi-windup encore, while two other bouts will be added.

### BUTTER ADVANCES

PORTLAND, Ore., 22. —(P)—(Market Notes)—Previous advances in the local butter and egg market were maintained today but no further gains were shown in either commodity. On the dairy exchange quotations were again posted at former levels in all grades.

Local jobbers report offerings of fresh butter extremely light with a brisk demand for both high score and ordinary stock. At the same time storage holdings are very light and the market firm.

Weather conditions have been ideal so far this fall but butterfat production has shown only a moderate increase with some creameries still reporting a shortage. Cream bids are still high, but more in line with print prices than they were ten days ago. Bids in the country range in

around 55 to 56 cents f. o. b. shippers' track. Prices for cream delivered in Portland range from 58 to 59 cents. Fresh eggs are very scarce with a good shipping outlet. Jobbers are getting only limited receipts and are holding at strong prices. Storage stocks are still heavy but being reduced rapidly. Additional exports this week to the British market have strengthened the local situation considerably.

The live poultry market is generally steady. Turkey arrivals are scarce.

### RUSSIAN ILLITERATES DELINE

RIGA, Sept. 28.—(P)—The proportion of illiterates in Russia has been reduced from 777 per thousand in 1914, to 500 per thousand at the present time. Among the vast amount of reading matter freely circulated in Soviet Russia today, in contradistinction to pre-war Russia, scientific works are most in demand. Books on political economy and sociology are given preference. Other very popular sciences are chemistry, astronomy and biology.

### INVADE BULGARIA

SOFIA, Bulgaria, Oct. 22.—(P)—It is officially reported that Greek troops have invaded Bulgarian territory. No declaration of war, however, has been received from the Athens government.

### CURIOUS ORIGIN OF BUILDING RECALLED BY ALTERATIONS

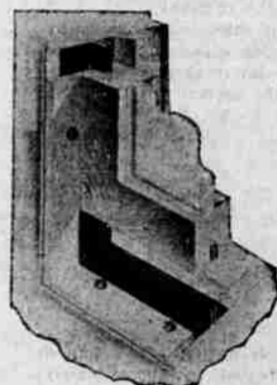
SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 22.—(P)—A brokerage firm is making interior alterations in the Parrott building, a structure built in 1852 of stones brought from China.

When the ship sailed in from Hongkong and landed at the single wharf the city then had, Chinese coolies secured the great stones to bamboo poles and carried them to the site. There was no derrick, and the stones were lifted into place by a primitive system of poles and ropes. But the coolies, directed by an American contractor, did a good job.

The little three-story building stood staunchly through the 72 years of progress. It was one of the few downtown to survive the earthquake and fire of 1906. It presents a strange contrast to the glossy surfaces of the giant structures of San Francisco's "Wall Street." Although interior improvements are being made, the exterior, built to endure, will not be changed.
