**OIL SHALE INDUSTRY PAYS ENORMOUS DIVIDENDS**

TOKYO.—Japan's oil shale industry in Manchuria probably will develop into one of the big assets of the Empire, said Viscount Masatoshi Okochi, professor in the Tokyo Imperial University and a noted metallurgical authority, upon his return from a prolonged inspection trip.

He declared in general that the industry bids fair to succeed if the dry distillation system of oil shale is conducted according to the approved method which is used in Scotland. Coal is used for fuel in this method, which is an advantageous factor since Pushun has the largest colliery in the Far East.

ations her troops have taken from the Bulgarians until full satisfaction has been accorded in the way of reparations and apology from Bulgaria.

The fact that Roumania, Czechoslovakia and Jugo-Slavia apparently will remain neutral in the conflict has created a feeling of satisfaction here.

One of the features of the situation, which is causing some misleaders opposed to the Bulgarian givings, is a report that Agrarian movement have arrived at the frontier at Zaribrod with the purpose of harassing the government while it has its hands full in dealing with the Greeks.

**Peace Is Urged**

With scarcely breathing time after their Locarno security pact labors, Aristide Briand, president of the council of the league of nations and Austen Chamberlain, the British foreign secretary again are ready to aid in putting Europe's house in order and keeping it peaceful.

The fact that apparently neither Bulgaria nor Greece thus far has obeyed the injunction of M. Briand as president of the council to withdraw their troops behind their respective frontiers caused considerable uneasiness in league circles while officials were awaiting the opening of the council meeting.

**Greek Version Denied**

The new Bulgarian note to the league emphatically denies the Greek version as to the origin of and responsibility for the conflict. The note states that the Bulgarians proposed the appointment of commission of inquiry at the outset, but that the Greek government failed to reply and dispatched considerable hostile forces into Bulgarian territory.
