Two O. A. C. Stars Are Out of Game

CORVALLIS, Ore., Oct. 27. (AP)—Wes Schulmerich, mainstay of the Oregon Agricultural backfield, and Bell, fullback in the pony combination, are out of the game for an indefinite period as the result of injuries suffered in the Stanford game last Saturday. For a while yesterday it was feared Schulmerich's leg was fractured, but an x-ray revealed a torn ligament. He may be back in the lineup for the Montana game next Saturday. Bell's injury is more serious, and is expected to keep him out for most if not all of the season.

Post mortems on the Stanford game since the return of the squad revealed that the Aggies had a powerful and smart offensive, but it was pointed out that they lacked a hard game preceding the Stanford clash to add finish to the team work.

Oakland to Build Another New Model

PONTIAC, Mich., Oct. 27.—Orders for special machinery and equipment totalling nearly \$3,000,000 have already been placed to build the new car announced recently by the General Motors Corporation. This car will be produced and distributed by the Oakland Motor Car company as a companion to the present Oakland Six.

A. J. Brandt, works manager at Oakland, states that already 20 per cent of the new equipment has arrived and is being installed in the Oakland factories.

Seventy five tool designs have been engaged since early in June drawing up plans for the new machinery, tools and special equipment and 125 more men have been engaged in rearranging the layout of the factories for the production of the new car.

Mr. Brandt reports that 500 new machines have been ordered as part of the additional equipment necessary to build the engine alone. First production of the new cars will be handled on an assembly line paralleling the present Oakland assembly. Additional assembly lines will be placed in operation as production gets under way.

Oldsmobile Shows Bigger Economies

Automobile manufacturers are constantly striving to reduce manufacturing costs and thereby lower the selling price to the purchaser. Now they are reclaimed and do duty until worn out. This results in a considerable saving during the year and is but one of the many small economies successful automobile manufacturers are using to reduce expenses. The fact that automobiles today are selling for 25% less than they did before the war, while general commodities are selling for 67% more, shows that the manufacturers are successful in eliminating unnecessary costs.

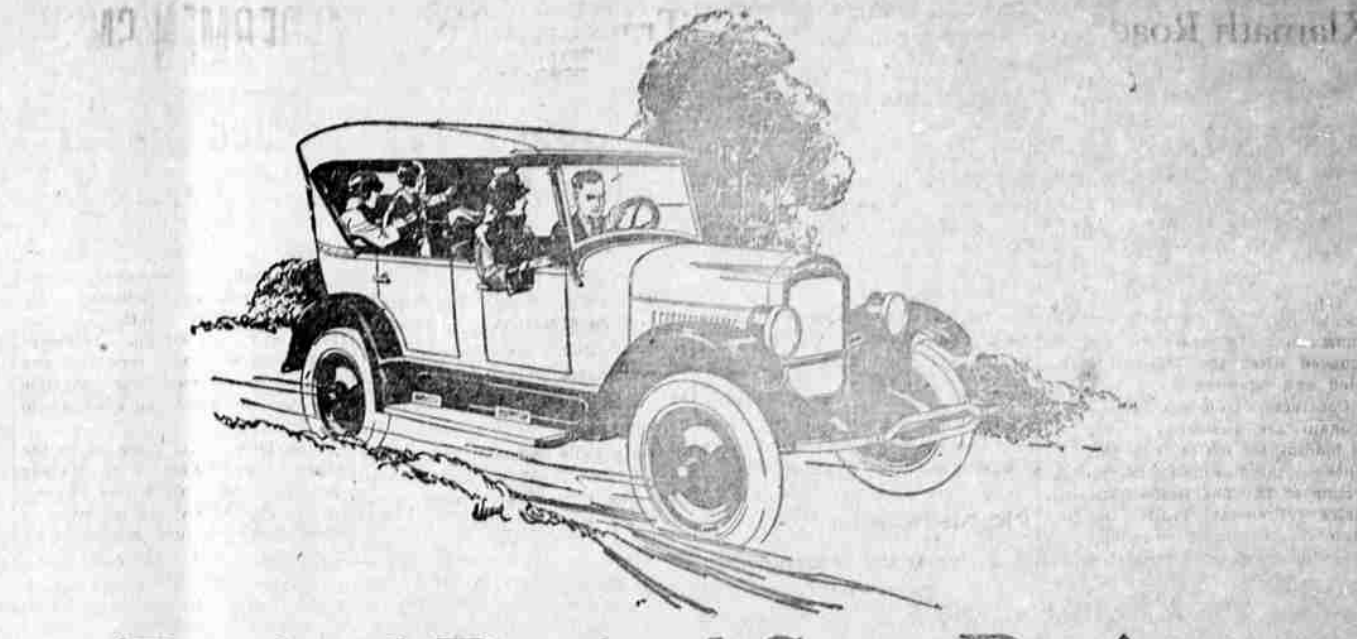
