outside of Board Meetings. Some responsible head must be on the job all the time to protect the great interests of the Klamath Irrigation District, a \$3,000,000.00 corporation. J. L. Jacob has attended all Board Meetings and sacrificed a great deal of his time outside the meetings, in the interest of the District. His duties as Director do not call for the constant attention necessary from the President. Charles E. Drew has given no attention to the District's business outside of Board Meetings, many of which the record shows he did not attend. He threw all the burden and responsibility on Jacob and Bradbury, attended to his own private affairs and neglected to attend Board Meetings. He now asks the voters to approve his record. Many days charged to Bradbury and Jacob were for attendance at Government hearings.

TAXI—
There have been many visits here by high officials of the Reclamation Service in the past and it has been the invariable custom of the COPCO to immediately attach themselves to the visiting officials and escort them in COPCO cars to see what COPCO wanted them to see, the cars being packed with just the right people to tell them what the COPCO wanted them to hear. When Mead visited, this Springs, the Directors were determined that for once Reclamation officials should travel with District officials over the district and hear things from the water users' viewpoint. The only taxi or automobile hire that has been paid by the District during the past nine months was for one trip of the District officials accompanying Commissioner Mead and the voucher in payment, therefore, in amount \$16.00, shows on its face what the trip was for, so Wishard, who filled the editorial chair of the "NEWS" Wednesday night, and the other editors of that corporation sheet knew that fact when they published their attack of Thursday morning.

GASOLINE—
Heretofore, when A. L. Wishard was secretary of the District it has been his custom to hire an automobile when he made necessary trips over the District, at a cost of \$10 per day, or more. The present Secretary has made six trips over the District during the past nine months, but instead of hiring a car at ten dollars per day he borrowed one and the total cost to the District has been:

Oil, etc.....1.65
Gasoline.....8.78
10.43

a total cost of \$10.43 for the six trips, an average of \$1.74 per trip. One ten dollar gasoline book was purchased in which still remains tickets to the amount of \$1.22.
