Hundreds of cars of freight which leaves Klamath Falls for the middle west and eastern states is the attraction which has brought to this country a group of traffic men representing different eastern railroads. Numbered in this group are O. F. Spindler, of San Francisco, general agent for the Chicago, Great Western railroad; W. W. Smith of San Francisco, district freight agent for the Soo lines; T. E. Hoke of Portland, freight agent for the Pennsylvania lines; S. E. Burnett of Portland, agent for the Chicago, Rock Island railroad lines; and J. F. Scanlin of Seattle, freight agent for the New York Central lines.

These railroad men did not come to Klamath together, but one by one, and their presence here at the same time is a coincidence. They will interview shippers and quote freight rates to them.

DEATH CAUSE IS PROBED BY JURY

Inquest. Josephine Jackson, the fifth occupant of the death car, is recovering in the Klamath Valley hospital from a broken shoulder, bruises and abrasions.

The tragedy occurred on a straight stretch of road about a half mile north of the Lakeview-Merrill junction. Jackson, apparently speeding in a southerly direction, had just jessed a south bound car. As he was swerving around the front of the car, one of the rear tires of his automobile blew out. Simultaneously he slammed on the brakes. The brakes and the blow-out sloughed the car around sideways and the momentum of its speed caused it to roll over twice.

Victim in Rear Seat

Miss Lawver was sitting in the rear seat with Miss Jackson and Sanchez. As the car turned over, her head was caught between the back of the rear seat and the hard macadam road. It was crushed to a pulp and beyond recognition. Death came instantaneously, according to physicians.

Sanchez and Willis, who was in the front seat, were uninjured, but Jackson, the driver, is suffering slightly from a bruised left leg. Jackson is being held in jail.

Jackson maintained that another man, a white man, was driving the car. He said that he did not know his name but had picked him up in Klamath Falls. His story, according to the district attorney's office, was not corroborated by the stories of other survivors of the crash, and as a result the tale is given little credence.

Jackson and his sister are from Sprague river. It was the unanimous opinion of officers who investigated the wreck a few minutes after that Jackson was under the influence of intoxicating liquor.

No Trace of Perez Found up to 3 P. M.

Owing to the fact that the Mexicans will not push a criminal action against their former friend, no warrant has been sworn out for Perez's arrest.
