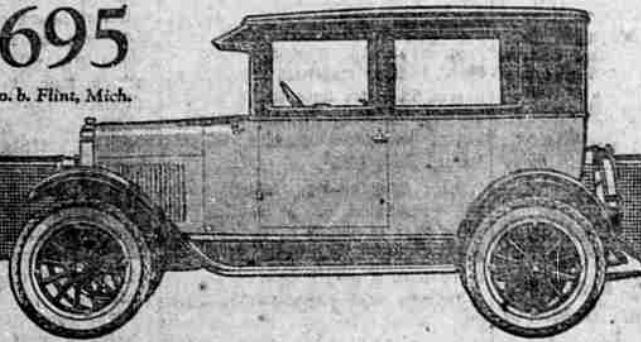

Thomas Vaughn Is Convicted Of Running Still
Circuit Court Jury Deliberates 10 Minutes On Case
A verdict of guilty against Thomas Vaughn, charged with operating a moonshine still, was returned by a circuit court jury shortly before noon today. The jury deliberated ten minutes.
Vaughn will be sentenced Friday morning at 10 a. m. Also at that time Judge Leavitt will pronounce sentence on Roy Darling, charged with a statutory crime.

Long Inquiry Comes To End
Shenandoah Probe is Provisionally Closed
WASHINGTON, Nov. 25. (AP)—The navy's long investigation of the Shenandoah disaster came to a provisional end today, the probe being based on the possible summoning of Colonel Wm. Mitchell, who previously had declined to testify before the naval court of inquiry.
As the court adjourned today, subject to call of its president, Rear Admiral Hilary P. Jones, it was announced by Judge Advocate Leonard that should he find upon examination of Colonel Mitchell's testimony before the army court martial any matters germane to the Shenandoah inquiry he would seek a process to bring the colonel before the naval tribunal.

CHILDREN GIVEN WIDOW'S ESTATE
Mrs. Jeanette Myer Tells Them to Carry on
PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 25. (AP)—The bulk of the capital stock of the Meier and Frank company store and of the Meier and Frank Investment company, which was held by the late Jeanette Meier, who died last week, has been left to her children, Abraham Meier, Julius L. Meier, and Mrs. Fannie Clark, with admittance to carry on and to bring up their children and their children's children to carry on the business enterprise that was founded in Portland by her husband, A. Meier.
Twenty-two charities will receive from \$250 to \$3750 under the will, a total of \$13,650.
Mrs. Meier's will was filed in probate court today, naming the three children executors without bond.

France Still Needs Cabinet
Senator Paul Doumer Declines to Accept Task
PARIS, Nov. 25. (AP)—France was still without a cabinet tonight which resigned Sunday following an adverse vote by the chamber of deputies on the government's finance bill.
Refusal of the various groups in the chamber of deputies to promise support for his financial plans caused Senator Paul Doumer today to decline the task of forming a new ministry, as it did M. Baird yesterday.
Former Premier Edouard Herriot, radical leader and president of the chamber of deputies was summoned this afternoon by President Doumergue but failure of his projected "concentration" cabinet on the left is considered likely in well informed circles.

Murder Trial Under Way Medford Court
MEDFORD, Ore., Nov. 25.—The testimony in the trial of Omar W. Murphy, well known local resident charged with manslaughter, as a result of an alleged beating administered to his wife, Ella, last March, ranged today from the childish words of the 11 year old daughter of the defendant, and ponderous answers of medical men, to hypothetical questions that took three minutes to propound.
The little girl, Erlene Murphy, when the cross examination by the defense started, cried and ran from the court room, after giving evidence for father.
Damaging Testimony
The most damaging testimony given by the little miss was ordered stricken from the records by the court upon objection of the defense. Erlene testified that she had been told to "tell the truth," and that her father had told her brother, Earl, in her presence:
"I only gave her a spanking. She is just staying in bed for sympathy, and so the neighbors will know all about it."
Earl, the brother, was a witness at the morning session.
Expert testimony was given by Doctor V. S. Geary, county health officer; Dr. C. R. Moser, of Grants Pass, and Dr. E. A. Woods, of Ashland.
Experts Testify
Each testified in response to a hypothetical question by the state, that all the vital organs being normal, as shown by an autopsy, death could only be caused by an embolism, or blood clot. An embolism, the physicians explained, was caused by bruises, and might not be detected in an autopsy, even with a microscope. An embolism follows the blood flow, and blocks the smaller veins, being fatal in three vital centers, the heart, the lungs and the brain.
The state contends that Mrs. Murphy was severely beaten about the hips and that an embolism was the cause of death.

Roof Caves In; Woman Injured
BEND, Ore., Nov. 25. — Women engaged in nailing boards on a tabernacle being erected close to the downtown district yesterday narrowly escaped serious injury when the roof and one side of the building fell. Mrs. George Kessler of Powell Butte, one of the women at work on the building, was hit by falling boards, but not seriously hurt. Lack of supports in the center of the building was thought to be responsible for the accident.
The building which was to have a seating capacity of 800, was being erected by contributed labor. Women worked with men nailing on the weather boards especially during the day time, while men worked at night under electric lights strung from low poles. Only a few men were present yesterday when the roof and side fell in.

Wreck Bridge By Explosion
ASTORIA, Ore., Nov. 25. (AP)—Detonation of a giant blast of pyroto explosive to break up a log jam which has existed for several years immediately above the bridge over the Neacoxie creek at Bearhart, popular summer resort, damaged the bridge and caused the washout of a portion of one approach with the resultant collapse of the pavement, an investigation by the Clatsop county court revealed today.
The blast was ordered set by the Gearhart city council to break up the log jam so the logs could be carried away by the tide. The blast was too powerful, racking the walls of the bridge approach, enabling the tide to gnaw at the sand fills of the approach.
The bridge was completed last summer.

LEADERS FOUND GUILTY
LONDON, Nov. 25. (AP)—A verdict of guilty was returned today against the 12 communist leaders tried in Old Bailey on charges of conspiring to publish seditious libels and violations of the incitement to mutiny act.
