The attention of the city council is called to the condition of the Esplanade at the railroad trestle, particularly on the north side of the street. The contractor opening this street should be compelled to maintain the street in a passable condition. The fact that a sewer connection had to be made at this point was known in sufficient time to have had this street put back in proper condition by the Warren Construction company. That it was not done should be no reason for permitting this open ditch to remain there all winter. It should be filled and maintained at street level throughout the winter. As it is now it is a menace to travel and a disgrace to the city.

The attention of the readers of the Evening Herald is directed to the suggestions offered by Dr. Newsom, city health officer. There is no necessity for public uneasiness, but there is wisdom in taking ordinary precaution. By maintaining the health at the highest point of perfection, it is an insurance against the inroads of disease. It also is wise to summon the family physician where any symptoms of sickness appear, following the old adage that "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure."

STEWART'S WASHINGTON LETTER

WASHINGTON—The United States senate is caught at last—caught in a trap it helped to set.

At the last session of congress the senate acquiesced in the District of Columbia compulsory education bill, now a law, which provides that all children in the District under 14 years of age must attend school regularly.

In the 68th congress more than half of the senate's pages were under 14.

Superintendent of Schools Frank W. Ballou says this must stop.

Seventeen years ago congress enacted a district anti-child labor law which, as originally proposed, would have accomplished what the new law appears to have accomplished now.

At the last minute, however, it occurred to some senator that prohibition of the employment of children under 14 probably would be construed as including congressional pages. Accordingly the bill was amended to leave them out.

The house of representatives accepted the amendment, but didn't like it, and never since has employ-

ed a page below the minimum age limit for the rest of the District. The senate has.

Doubtless the senators would have tried to amend the compulsory education bill, too, if anybody had thought of it, but nobody did.

Due to this oversight the measure slipped through and unless the senate decides to defy it, as law, which it can't do with a good grace, it seems certain to have to abide by what Dr. Ballou says.

Explosion Wrecks Montana Hospital

KALISPELL, Mont., Dec. 14. (AP)—Authorities here probing every available clue in the dynamiting of Sisters of Mercy Hospital late Saturday, in an effort to capture the perpetrator. Although patients, nurses and sisters of the order were endangered by the blast, no one was injured, but the explosion smashed all the windows of the front part of the building and badly damaged the dining room.

NEW CARDINALS CREATED TODAY

ROME, Dec. 14. (AP)—Four new cardinals were created at a secret consistory today. They are:

Monsignor Bonaventura Cerretti, apostolic nuncio in France.

Monsignor Enrico Gasparri, apostolic nuncio in Brazil.

Monsignor Patrick O'Donnell, archbishop of Armagh.

Monsignor Alessandro Verde, secretary of the congregation of rites.

Cardinal Cerretti is well known in the United States, having been auditor to the apostolic collection at Washington. He expects to visit the United States again in about six months in order to attend the Eucharistic congress at Chicago.

Cardinal Gasparri is a nephew of the papal secretary of state and has been in the papal diplomatic body for 25 years, most of this time being spent in Latin American countries. Cardinal Verde is one of the most learned ecclesiastics in the Roman congregations and is known particularly in the Beatification and Canonization of Jean of Arc.

QUARANTINE TO BE ESTABLISHED

merited it, at the same time agreed to support the quarantine when the time came. Dr. Newsom explained to the merchants that such a move, while regrettable from a business point of view, would be necessary from the point of view of public health and safety.

Conference Decision

At the conference of physicians held shortly before 1 p. m. 12 of the 15 doctors present favored the partial quarantine. Two physicians held that the move was unnecessary and that with the schools open, a more direct supervision and surveillance of the children could be maintained. They pointed out that the children would probably mingle on the streets and that such meetings could not be controlled.

The remaining 13 doctors declared the partial quarantine perfectly justifiable according to reports. Their position was that the situation was serious enough at the present time, and that public health authorities should take all proper precautions to prevent a further spread of meningitis.

10-Day Epidemic

The spinal meningitis epidemic originated in Klamath Falls 10 days ago in Pelican City school. One child, an eight year old boy, was stricken with the malady and a few days later died. The second case came several days later, a lonely middle-aged homesteader in the Bonanza district, who died three days after he was taken to the hospital.

For two or three days, no further outbreak of the sickness was noted and health authorities were reasonably optimistic. Then last Friday, two more cases were reported, a man of about 40 years and a child ten years and yesterday a fifth case developed at the Sacred Heart academy.

The pool rooms will be allowed to remain open for the sale of tobacco and soft drinks, but crowds will not be allowed to gather for card playing or other amusements, it was said by the health authorities.

Greece To Pay Big Reparation

GENEVA, Switzerland, Dec. 14. (AP)—Greece violated the Pulgarin frontier in the recent incident between the two nations and must pay reparation of 30,000,000 leva (about \$215,000), the league of nations council today decided.

The council adopted a report by Sir Austen Chamberlain of Great Britain, and Viscount Ishii of Japan. This report found Greece's invasion of Bulgaria unjustifiable, maintaining that the Broad principle, where territory is violated without sufficient cause, reparation is due, even if at the time of the occurrence it was believed by the party committing the violation that circumstances verified the action.

The report thus rejected Greece's reference to the Corfu incident (in which Italy temporarily took possession of that island), on the ground that it was justifiable and aggression.

The council also adopted a proposal by Sir Austen that two Swedish officers act as arbitrators of border disputes between Greece and Bulgaria.

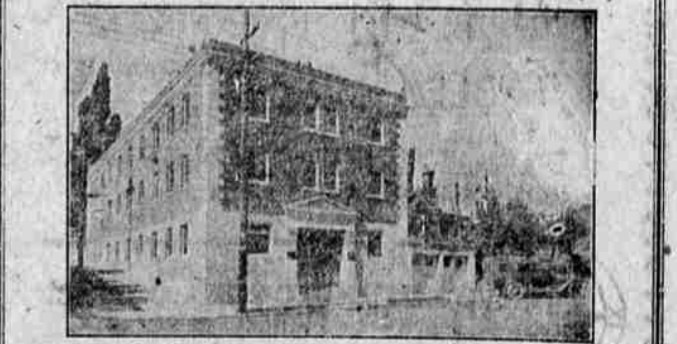
REFUSE REQUEST
