Demon Rum Is Squelched, Is U. S. Testimony

Border Leaks Checked, But Few Holes Still Left

WASHINGTON, Dec. 18.—(P)—A detailed picture of federal prohibition enforcement machinery along the Canadian and Mexican borders, the seacoast and inland waterways, was presented in testimony at hearings by a house appropriations subcommittee made public today.

Rum row on the Atlantic was represented as "effectively scattered," the effectiveness of the enforcement armed treasury department as "materially bolstered" and leaks along the two borders as "checked but not wholly plugged."

Testifying as to border smuggling, Ernest W. Camp, director of customs said a day and night patrol cut down the chances of success, but that he did not "believe the army could stop liquor coming across."

The child was said to have drowned in a bathtub after its arms were tied, and the body was hidden in the yard of the Kamora home at Tracy. The body was found by workmen several months later. A three year old child was with Mrs. Kamora at the time of her arrest.

Ask Rum Probe in Foreign Embassies

WASHINGTON, Dec. 18.—(P)—A treasury investigation of the use of liquors in foreign embassies and legations here would be ordered under a resolution referred today by Senator Blease, democrat, South Carolina.

The resolution further asked whether the Italian debt commission brought liquor into the United States, and if they did so, why they were not arrested.
