**KLAMATH FAILS
TO RECOVER SUM**

(Continued from page one)

a balance of \$25,000 due Klamath county from security companies, as guarantors of security of cer-
tain county funds, deposited in the
defunct bank. The settlement, de-
scribed below in excerpts of the
judge's decision, was a mutual agree-
ment between the parties concern-
ed and was to the effect that the
surety companies should pay \$15,-
500 and the insolvent bank \$9,500
of the sum due the county.

Following are salient excerpts of
the proposed settlement:
Proposal

"The Surety companies, in con-
sideration of such acquittance, are
to pay Klamath county the sum of
\$15,500.00.

"The order prepared and submit-
ted along with the petition, for the
court to sign, authorizing the set-
tlement, provides:

(a) That in addition to the
payment of \$15,500.00, by the
Surety Companies to Klamath coun-
