Proponents of the Shippington bridge plan, insist that the building of California avenue is but one more argument for building the bridge at Shippington instead of below the Copco. They hold that but six or seven individuals would be benefited by the span being built below the dam whereas literally hundreds would be benefited by the bridge at Shippington. In other words, their war cry is "the greatest good to the greatest number."
