

Oregon Berries Now on Market

ROSEBURG, Ore., April 13. (AP)—Umpqua valley strawberries were placed on the local market today, the earliest that they have ever appeared in crate lots. Indications are that there will be an abundance of berries this season and that there will be a sufficient quantity available for shipment to outside markets by the end of the week. Local prices today were 35 cents per box.

ANCIENT CATS JEROME, Ariz., April 13. (AP)—Tracks of giant cats that trod the soil of Arizona about 100,000 years ago were discovered by Professor H. H. Nininger of McPherson college, Kansas. The tracks are imbedded in limestone which was unearthed beneath more than 100 feet of sediment of the pleistocene period. The tracks are six inches in diameter. The discovery is one of the most important paleontological discoveries ever made in the southwest, the professor believes.

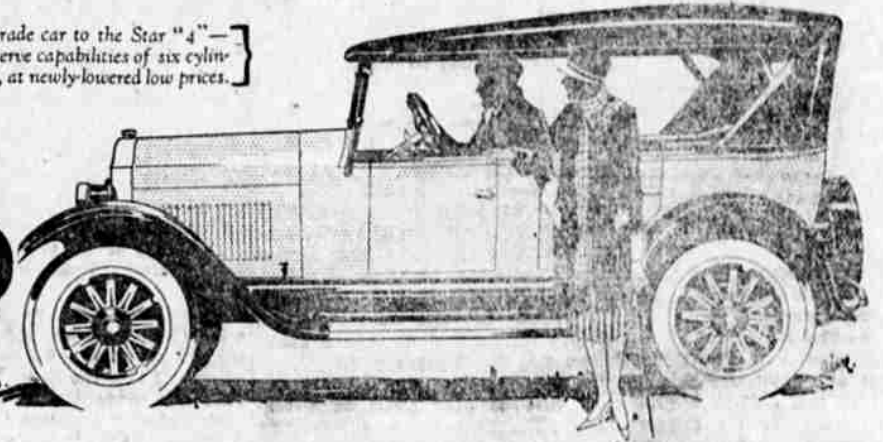
