Stock Prices Stage Rallies

NEW YORK, April 21. (P) - Stock prices today staged one of the most impressive recoveries since the drastic reaction last month. Resumption of pool operations which have been facilitated by the cheap money rates and the advent of warmer weather which is expected to stimulate spring business were the dominant factors, but close attention also was paid to the favorable nature of most of the quarterly reports of railroad and industrial corporations now making their appearance. Revival of merger talk accelerated the demand for the railroad shares, which also were helped by the march earnings statements of the principal systems and the continuance of relatively heavy freight car loadings.
