More Teeth For Dry Law Planned

WASHINGTON, April 28.—(AP)—After serving as a new vehicle for expression of wet and dry sentiment in the house, the bill to give legislative sanction to the reorganization of the treasury's enforcement agencies has been added to the senate's list of pending administration bills to make prohibition more drastic.

The bill would raise the prohibition unit and the customs service to the status of bureaus headed by commissioners appointed by the treasury secretary. These bureaus, with the coast guard, would be grouped under the direction of a single assistant secretary charged with supervision of prohibition enforcement. The measure also carries an amendment to place all except the highest prohibition officials under civil service regulations.

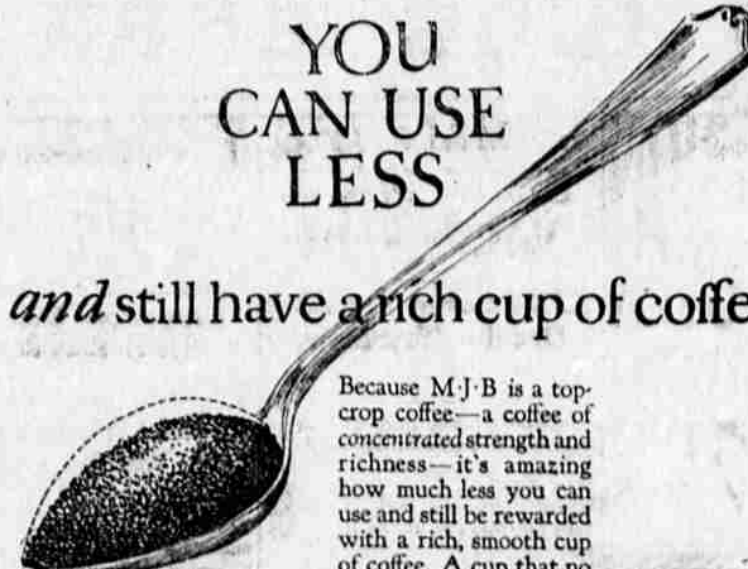

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Indian Music Is Studied By Yale Teacher

Klamaths Visited by Authority on Such Matters

YREKA, Calif., April 28.—(Special to The Herald.)—To learn the music of the Klamath Indians, their folk and tribal songs, their intonation and their sense of rhythm, Helen H. Roberts of the Yale university institute of psychology spent several weeks in the vicinity of Somes Bar. She has left for Eureka, where she will continue her studies before returning to the East.

The music of the various tribes of Indians throughout the United States has become an intensive study on the part of Miss Roberts, who will turn over her findings to the institute for publication as soon as she has compiled the data gathered. Little or nothing is known of the music of the Klamaths, so Miss Roberts made the cross continent trip for the express purpose of gaining information about this tribe.

While Miss Roberts was at Somes Bar, many of the older members of the tribe who are versed in the history of the Klamaths spent hours singing tribal songs and then explained the meaning of each song and the part that it played when the Klamaths ruled the great Siskiyou region.

Urges Coast Man Replacing Haney

WASHINGTON, April 28. (AP)—President Coolidge was urged by Senator McNary, republican, Oregon, today to fill as soon as possible the shipping board vacancy from the northwest states caused by the resignation of Commissioner Haney of Oregon.

The controversy over the sale of the Admiral-Oriental line, running out of Seattle, is of intense interest to the people of the northwest, the senator said, and that section particularly needs a representative on the board at this time. After he left the White House he said he was very hopeful the president would act.
