DIRECTORS SEEK PLAYERS TO BOLSTER UP PELICAN LINE-UP; WIRES ARE HOT

Stung into action by the decisive defeat suffered by the Klamath Falls Pelicans at the hands of Medford last Sunday, local directors are burning up the wires to locate two players, one a pitcher, and another probably an outfielder. DeMaris, outfielder has resigned from the team. His position in the outfield will probably be filled by Duback, second baseman, and Duback's former position will be filled by Brady Montgomery, who has been playing utility.

"We have been trying to locate Streitenmeyer, former O. A. C. star, and if possible will hire him before next Sunday's game so he can play a week from Sunday," Bert Cook, local director said.

Need To Be Bolstered

"We have the best ball club in the southern Oregon baseball league. They need to be bolstered up a bit in weak spots, and then nothing can stop us. We have a better financial inducement for Streitenmeyer to come, than when negotiations were first started. Understand he has tentatively signed with a Portland semi-pro team, but if possible we will get him here."

by their Sunday defeat, the local nine has donned its fighting togs and is out for blood.
