BAYNESS LET OFF BY LEAGUE DIRECTORS AT MEETING LAST NIGHT

Crabbing at umpires of the Southern Oregon baseball league will be met by a stiff fine and possible banishment of the offending player from the league it was decided at a meeting of directors of the Southern Oregon Baseball league held in Ashland last night.

"Frenchy" Bayness, Klamath 3rd sacker, was left off for his action in threatening Umpire Lettore here in the Medford game last Sunday but will be officially warned by the league to discontinue this practice in the future.

Cooperation Manifest

A fine spirit of cooperation was manifest at last night's meeting according to Bert Cook, Klamath's representative in the league board of directors. Cook attended the Ashland meeting in company with Tom Watters, prominent Klamath rancher and Klamath Falls business man, who has from sheer love of sportsmanship contributed his time each Sunday to umpiring the league games played by the Klamath club.

No More Wraggling

Hereafter no player will be permitted to take part in an argument with the umpire except the captains or managers of the ball clubs taking part. "The fans don't like this wraggling and it has got to stop, that was the unanimous verdict of all the directors," said Cook.

A new controversy which developed at the Grants Pass-Ashland game last Sunday, with regard to a disputed run which gave the game to Ashland in the eleventh inning, was ironed out last night by the directors ordering the two clubs to play off the protested game at Medford, on neutral grounds, on July 4, with Tom Watters of Klamath Falls acting as umpire.

The use of the spit ball by an Ashland pitcher was settled by letting the bars down in all the league clubs against the use of the saliva pellet. The Klamath protest was dropped. Ashland however admitting the Klamath protest was justified.

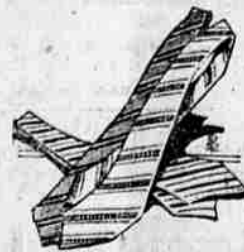
