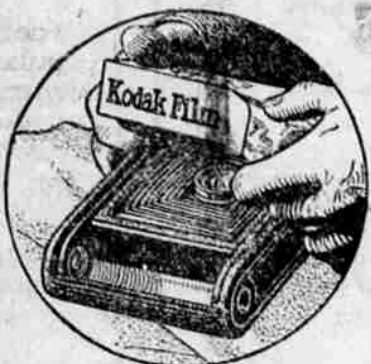

"Bobby" Jones Is Winner Of English Prize

Completes 72 Hole Grind In 291 Strokes Today

ST. ANNES, Eng., June 25.—(P) — Bobby Jones, American golfing marvel, today added the British crown to his long list of trophies.

He completed the 72-hole grind with an aggregate of 291 strokes.

A1 Watrous Grand Rapids professional, was second with 293. Walter Hagen tied with George Von Elm for third with 295, in an all American finish.

The trophy goes to the United States for the fifth time. It was first captured by a golfer from America in 1921 when Jock Hutchison won. Walter Hagen was victorious in 1922 and again in 1924 while Long Jim Barnes won last year.
