A JOURNALISTIC MARTYR

ASSASSINATION of Don R. Mellett, publisher of the Canton, Ohio, Daily News, again demonstrates that criminals, in addition to being cowards, are almost invariably creatures of low mentality and weak reasoning powers - says the Portland Mr. Mellett was murdered because of activities against the gambling element in Canton. He had received frequent warnings of the fate which was planned for him, but declined to abandon his fight against the gamblers. A spectacular tragedy of this nature is often a more powerful influence for reform than all of the publicity which the dead publisher could give the evil which he was fighting.

The Canton gamblers have killed Mellett but they have undoubtedly awakened a public sentiment that will avenge the death of the brave journalist in a manner far more drastic and effective than any punishment which might have followed the bloodless warfare which was being directed against the crimin-

The silenced voice of the murdered Mellett is a more powerful plea for the cause for which he died, than any that he could have made while living and the jeopardy in which his murderers have placed themselves will be increased accordingly.
