Rancher Unconscious Fol-
lowing Attempt to Save
Youth Who Drowns

GRANTS PASS, Ore., July 21. (P)
Howard Hoff, 20, of Glendora,
Calif., was drowned, and Steve
Maxey, who resides on a ranch four
miles from Grants Pass on the
Rogue River, was apparently life-
less after having been taken from
the river at noon today.

Several others when Hoff gave out
and cried for help. Several went
to his rescue, but were unable to
help and then Maxey plunged in to
aid. He was caught in a death
grip by Hoff and carried under.
Artificial respiration methods were
being used to restore Maxey to life
when a report of the accident was
telephoned here.

Hoff was a student at LaVerne
college (California), and was a mem-
ber of the Clarion quartet which
sang in Grants Pass last night. He
is the son of the pastor of the
Brethren church at Glendora.

Two of the other swimmers
were also members of the quartet.
Maxey has a wife and a six months
old baby.
